MOTION TO CONTINUE MARCH **23, 2022 HEARING ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO** DISMISS THE INDICTMENT

The State of Idaho, by and through the Fremont County Prosecuting Attorney's Office hereby moves the Court to continue the hearings currently set for Wednesday, March 23, 2022, at 9:30 a.m., based on the following:
