In his Order dated August 18, 2022, in case CR22-21-1624 the court conceded that for the purpose of this motion the movant holds the status of "any person, and therefore has standing pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32.


In this consolidated matter, the court frequently and consistently has limited the public and the media's right to access hearings and documents without a prior hearing or sufficient justification.

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ICAR 32, the Idaho Constitution, and the U.S. Constitution require that the public and the media be permitted access to court records and proceedings subject to certain limited exceptions. The rules further require that the court hold a hearing after notifying all interested parties before sealing documents or closing proceedings.

Idaho law recognizes the legal standing of members of the media to file motions in court matters for the limited purpose of challenging the media's right to access court documents and closed hearings.
