Before the Court is Defendant's MOTION TO ALLOW CAMERAS/LIVE STREAMING filed September 29, 2022. The State filed its RESPONSE on October 6, 2022 arguing that the motion should be denied without hearing. As further explained herein, the Court denies the MOTION without need for a hearing.

On September 15, 2022 the Court held a hearing in the Co-Defendant Case CR22-21-1624, after which the Court entered in this case its September 23, 2022 ORDER pursuant to I.C.A.R. 45(a) and (b), revoking the authorization of future video and photographic coverage. The Court further referenced the rationale for the decision in its MEMORANDUM DECISION AND ORDER entered in the Co-Defendant case.

Because this case is currently joined for trial with the Co-Defendant case, the Court's ORDER revoking authorization of cameras in this case will remain in effect. However, the Court notes that a MOTION TO SEVER the cases is pending, and will be argued at a hearing on October 13, 2022. In the event the Court orders a severance of the cases, the Court will permit this issue to be revisited, as the considerations for separate cases would warrant separate arguments. For those

reasons, the MOTION TO ALLOW CAMERAS is denied without prejudice, and may be rescheduled for hearing in the event a severance is ordered.
