On Thursday, January 26, 2023, the Court received the State's MOTION TO SEAL STATE'S MOTION FOR INTRODUCTION OF EVIDENCE PURSUANT TO I.R.E. 401, 402, 403, & 404(B).

Pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(i)(1) the Court finds that temporarily sealing the *State's Motion* for *Introduction of Evidence Pursuant to I.R.E.* 401, 402, 403, 404(b) is appropriate until the Court can call a hearing to determine and make a finding of fact as to whether the interest in privacy or public disclosure predominates.
