1. The above-named appellant, Aaron Anson Ehlinger, by and through his attorney of record, Jon R. - 2. That the party has a right to appeal to the Idaho Supreme Court, and the judgment of conviction and order of commitment judgments or orders described in paragraph 1 above is are appealable orders under and pursuant to Idaho Appellate Rules (I.A.R.) 11(c)(1-9).
- 3. A preliminary statement of the issues on appeal, which the appellant then intends to assert in the appeal, provided any such list of issues on appeal shall not prevent the appellant from asserting other issues on appeal is:
  - (a) The court erred during trial in allowing the State to present evidence from witness Anne Wardle to support the allegations in the case despite defendant's objections. Such err or was not harmless.
  - (b) The court erred in not immediately declaring a mistrial when the complaining witness who took the witness stand abruptly left the witness stand and never returned.
  - (c) The court erred in denying the defendant's motion for Idaho Criminal Rule 29 at the close of the State's case in chief and further erred in the denial of defendant's post trial motion under ICR 29, and defendant's motion for a new trial.
