## 7 AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY

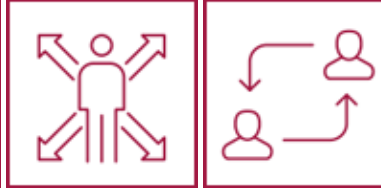


- Implementing energy efficiency measures across hospital operations

- **Target 13.2: Aligns with national and state climate policies, targeting a 25% reduction in hospital-wide carbon emissions by 2030 through renewable energy expansion, energy efficiency programs, and low-carbon mobility initiatives (telehealth, public transport encouragement, and digital reporting).**





- **Target 13.3: Integrates climate awareness and sustainability training into staff education, sensitizing employees to the health impacts of climate change and equipping them with the knowledge to support eco-friendly practices in their daily work.**

**Impact: KDAH actively quantifies and monitors its greenhouse gas emissions, ensuring transparency and accountability. By embedding climate action into healthcare delivery, the hospital not only reduces its own footprint but also contributes to healthier communities and a more sustainable future.**





Although KDAH, as a healthcare institution, has a limited direct impact on oceans, it recognizes the importance of protecting aquatic ecosystems through responsible practices.

- **Pollution Prevention:** Minimizes chemical and biomedical waste discharge into water systems by ensuring 100% safe and compliant treatment through STP, ETP, and approved biomedical waste vendors.
- **Sustainable Food Practices:** As a vegetarian institution, KDAH does not serve or consume seafood, thereby reducing pressure on marine resources and overfishing.
- **Local Sourcing:** Promotes the use of locally sourced food production, which reduces carbon footprint from transportation and supports regional sustainable agriculture.

**Impact:** Through eco-friendly waste management and responsible procurement, KDAH indirectly supports the preservation of aquatic life and the health of water ecosystems.



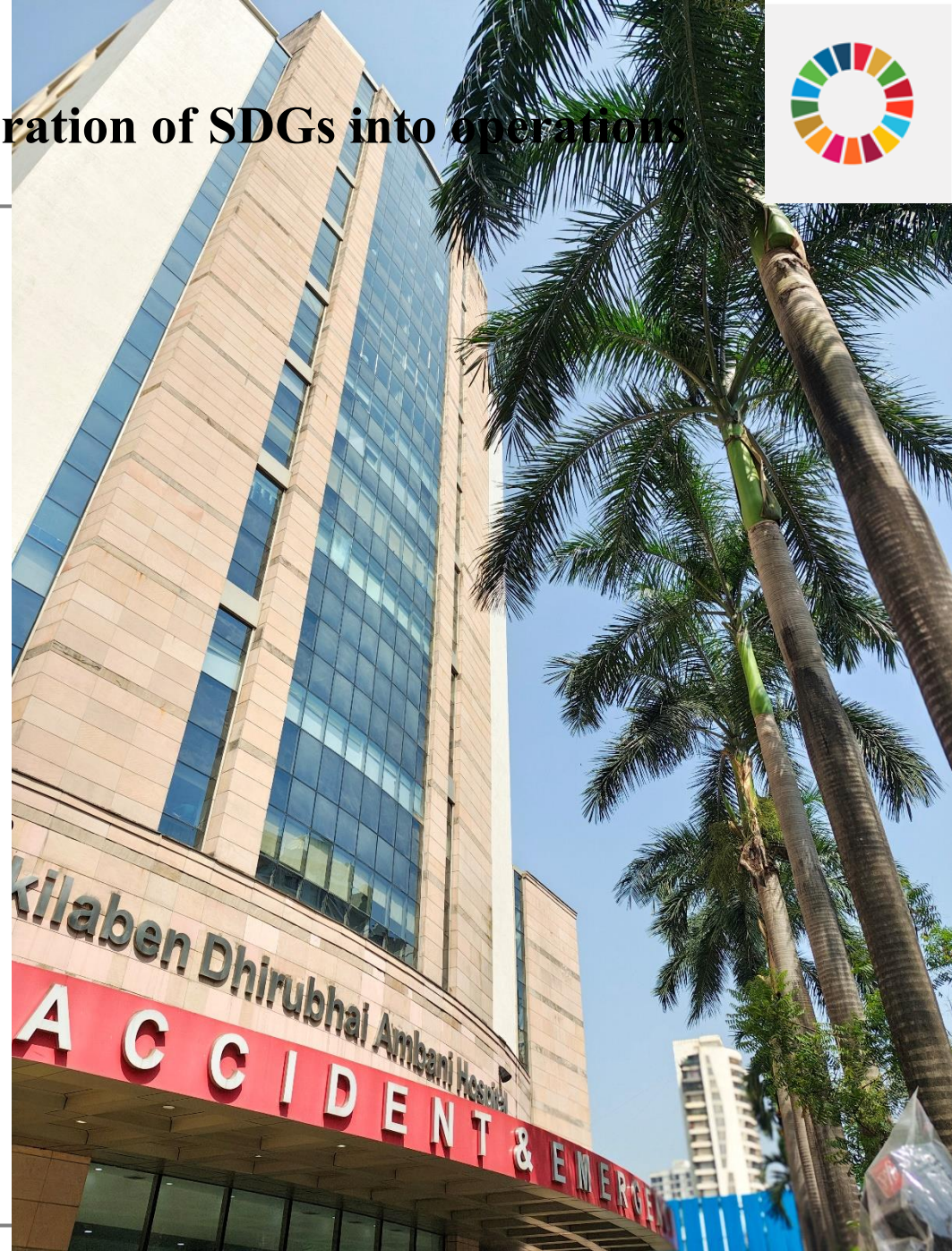
