
2022 COV/CORE CAMPING TRIP INFORMATION PACKET

Location

- Lake Del Valle Family Campground, 7000 Del Valle Rd, Livermore, CA (approx. 90 minutes SE of Vallejo)
- Our Campsite: Wild Turkey Group Campsite

Transportation/Parking

- Our group is allotted 15 parking spots, so carpool & parking assignments will be assigned. Each car must be pre-approved by and will receive a parking permit.
- **Passengers**: contact your carpool driver regarding departure time & location. Please be considerate and offer gas money. If you're bringing a lot of stuff, ask your driver if your items will fit in their car.
- **Drivers**: parking permits will be issued to you a few days in advance of the trip.
- Expect moderate-heavy traffic in Walnut Creek and Pleasanton if you leave Vallejo after 3:30PM on Thursday or Friday. **GATES CLOSE AT 10PM**. If you arrive after that, you will not be allowed in. Gates reopen at 6AM.

General Rules & Guidelines

Del Valle's 1) Quiet hours are from 10PM to 7AM. Amplification equipment and generators that disturb other campers will not be allowed at any hour. In consideration of our neighbors, please keep conversation and music to a minimum during these hours. 2) Wood collection is prohibited. Ground fires are not allowed except in the fire pits provided. Campfires must be attended at all times. 3) No firearms, fireworks, or weapons of any kind are allowed in the park.	 Lights out at 2AM. Last person should make sure campfire is completely extinguished. No coupling. Refrain from wandering off alone with a person of the opposite sex. No guys in ladies' tents and vice versa. There will be a men's tent area of the campgrounds and a ladies' tent area of the campgrounds. Please stay out of these respective areas if you do not belong there. In consideration of others, please exercise modesty in your general attire. Swimming attire: women wear one-piece suits (no bikinis or two pieces); men wear swimming shorts (no Speedos) and should wear a shirt at all times when not swimming. Make sure someone knows where you are at all times. If you plan on hiking, do NOT go alone. Let someone at the camp know which trail you are taking and who will be with you. Smoking is prohibited. Be safe during bathroom trips at night. PLEASE BE CAREFUL
4) Rope swings, hammocks, or other items that require hanging ropes from trees are prohibited.	as deer sometimes graze on the lawn between our camping sites and the bathrooms. Keep a safe distance and be aware of them. If you don't bother them, they won't bother you. 8) For questions regarding any other camping issues, please direct your questions to the COV/CORE staff.

Longitude: N 37° 33.923 Latitude: W 121° 40.997

- Take I-780 East towards Benicia/Martinez
- Take I-680 South toward San Jose/Martinez go 28.3 mi
- Take the I-580 East exit toward Livermore/Stockton go 8.6 mi
- Take the N Livermore Ave exit (Exit 52B) go south 3.4 mi through town
- Livermore Ave becomes Tesla Rd go 0.5 mi
- Turn right on Mines Rd go 3.5 mi
- Continue on **Del Valle Rd** go 4.5 mi
- Stop at the Guard Shack, then continue **<u>straight</u>** on Del Valle Rd.
- After you cross the bridge, make a left on Del Valle Rd.
- Drive approx. 1 mile, then make a **left** into the Campground entrance.
