Los Olivos Tennis & Pickleball Pavilion Rules

TRILOGY VINEYARD TENNIS CLUB:

The Trilogy Vineyards Tennis Club (TVTC) has the responsibility to ensure that tennis at all levels is available for all Homeowners* and their guests. Membership is open to any Homeowner for a nominal fee. The Board of the TVTC set the calendar of times for open play, competitive tennis, socials and USTA matches with other clubs. More information is available under the club tab at My Trilogy Life website, club page.

TRILOGY PICKLEBALL CLUB:

The Trilogy Vineyards Pickleball Club (TVPC) has the responsibility to ensure that pickleball at all levels is available for all Homeowners and their guests. Membership is open to any Homeowner for a nominal fee. The board of the TVPC sets the calendar of times for drop-in play, club tournaments, clinics, and events. We encourage residents that are interested in playing pickleball to join the pickleball club. Information on joining the club can be found on our My Trilogy Life website, club page.

PAVILION RULES

1. Court hours will be from 7:00 AM until 9:00 PM unless prior approval is given by the Resort Management for special arrangements.
2. Open play, instruction and social and competitive tournaments throughout the year are sponsored by the TVTC and TVPC.
3. Un-reserved courts are open on a first-come, first-serve basis. However, courts may be closed for club play, scheduled clinics, lessons, demos or tournaments as determined by the TVTC and the TVPC.
4. Any scheduled activity limiting court availability for members will be posted in the communication box in the Pavilion area in advance. Priority may be given to USTA (United States Tennis Association) and USAPA (United States of American Pickleball Association) sanctioned events.
5. Courts may be reserved by TVTC and TVPC members only using the Your Courts reservation system. <https://www.yourcourts.com/>. Any TVTC or TVPC member reserving a court must be a player during the reservation time (i.e., If you are the one making the reservation, you must also be the one playing on the reserved court.).
6. Court reservations shall not be permitted to individuals, groups, associations, clubs, or organizations desiring such use for "private gain" (private coaching), which term is defined herein to mean use for the principal purpose of making a profit not pledged to the HOA, the TVTC or the TVPC.
7. All hired (paid) coaches must provide the HOA with a copy of their insurance before any coaching takes place.

8. Only Homeowners and their guests may use the courts. Homeowners with guests may use no more than one court per residence when other Homeowners are waiting to play.
9. The tennis backboard (located on tennis court 2) is available for pickleball practice when no tennis is taking place on court 1 or 3.
10. Play (not reserved) is limited to one hour of playing time when others are waiting to play. The one (1) hour is the total time playing and not the time someone is waiting.
11. All players must wear proper attire while on the courts, including shirts, shorts, sweat suits or other appropriate athletic clothes and footwear. Cut offs and swimsuits are prohibited. Upper body garments must be worn at all times. All players must wear court shoes that do not mark the courts (NO black soled shoes allowed). Running shoes do not provide adequate lateral support for safe play on the courts and should not be used.
12. No food is allowed on the courts except in the pavilion area between the pickleball and tennis courts and on the concrete pad located between the Trilogy driveway and pickleball courts.
13. Drinks are only allowed on the courts in non-glass drinking containers.
14. No pets are allowed on the courts except certified service dogs assisting their assigned individual.
15. Tennis courts are for tennis and pickleball courts are for pickleball only.
No roller skates/blades, skateboards or bicycles are allowed on court surfaces.
16. Neither the VMCOA nor its Management Staff, the TVTC or the TVPC shall be responsible for injuries or accidents.
17. No smoking is allowed on the courts or in the pavilion area.
18. Ball machines (both tennis & pickleball) may not be used during peak morning hours of 7 AM to 11:30 AM or after 9PM– UNLESS no play is taking place.
19. Courtside posted rules and schedules must be observed. Upon repeated violation of the rules of Pavilion Rules the President of the TVTC or the TVPC with the concurrence of their respective Boards may recommend suspension of Homeowners/members from club activities, membership and/or use of the facilities to the Association's Citations Appeals Committee and Board of Directors.

*Homeowner(s) – Any person(s) living within Trilogy that own or lease a house.

**Member(s) – A Homeowner(s) that has/have paid the nominal fee to belong to TVTC and/or TVPC.

Los Olivos Tennis & Pickleball Pavilion Etiquette Rules

1. Read and follow "The Code" of Tennis and Pickleball for un-officiated matches.

2. No profanities, yelling or screaming at any time while on court.
3. All cell phones must be silenced.
4. No cassette/CD players or sound equipment without earphones are allowed on the courts
5. Show respect to all players at all times.
6. Keep the courts clean by picking up all garbage and disposing them in the trash or the recycling bin.
7. If you need to cross a court that is occupied to access yours, or the shed for equipment, please only cross in between games (with permission) or on the outside walkways and the appropriate gate.
8. Do not retrieve a ball from another court while their point is still in progress. Please wait until they finish their point. If your ball goes on another court for the safety of all players, firmly say, "Ball on" (This is for the safety of all players and is not applicable during USTA/USAPA Sanctioned play)
9. If you are around the Pavilion but not playing, please keep noises to an appropriate level and respect Homeowners/members who are playing.
10. Before starting play, ensure the court is free from hazards (extra balls, cans, standing water or other debris).
11. Always be safe. Do not participate in any behavior that would risk injury to anyone else, such as hitting balls when not in play, throwing racquets or paddles or any other object on or off the court.
12. If you remove any equipment from the shed or hangers (behind tennis court 2) the member is responsible for the proper utilization of the equipment (e.g. ball machine, broom, squeegee, blower etc.) to return to the shed area, placing the equipment in the designated location for storage and LOCK the shed

Note: Upon repeated violation of the rules, the President of the TVTC or the TVPA with the concurrence of their respective Boards may recommend suspension of members from club

activities, membership and/or use of the facilities to the VMCOA Compliance Committee.

There is an Automatic Electronic Defibrillator (AED) machine in the Pavilion Shed (right side) for the health and safety of our members and guests. Get trained on how to use the AED.

Have fun! The entire objective of playing tennis and pickleball, aside from being good aerobic exercise, is to have fun. You can follow these rules of etiquette and still have a good time on the courts – the players on adjacent courts will appreciate it.
