1. Trust: Citizen-Governance Disconnect

a. Measuring Citizen Trust

- 1 What are the important dimensions of citizen trust and what are the best measures of those dimensions?
- 2 What are reliable, least-cost options for capturing data to measure citizen trust?
- 3 How can local governments use AI tools to gather information on social media trends of the community? (tied to Emerging Technologies category)

b. Affecting Citizen Trust

- 1 How do local governments address the erosion of public trust in government?
- 2 How can compensation for community participation be a factor in building trust with disadvantaged communities?
- 3 How can participatory budgeting initiatives help build trust? (ties to Fiscal Health category)
- 4 How do local governments help residents better understand how their money is spent? (ties to the Fiscal Health category)

c. Engagement and Participation

- 1 How can we encourage people to participate in local governance?
- 2 What are alternate approaches for local governments to engage residents on issues?
- 3 What are alternate locations for local governments to engage residents on issues?
- 4 How does form of government impact trust between staff, elected officials and the community?

2. Emerging Technology in Local Government

a. Tech Industry Effects on Local Governments

- 1 How do technology companies set standards for technology needs of local governments?
- 2 How do technology companies drive innovation in local government instead of being driven by existing problems?

b. Local Government Evaluation of New Technologies

- 1 What expertise do local governments have and use to evaluate new emerging technologies?

- 3 How do local government managers navigate trade-offs of values in relation to adopting new technologies?
- 4 How should local government respond to new technologies impacting their communities?

3. Fiscal Health, Sustaining Services and Changing Government Roles

a. Provision and Production of Public Services

- 4 What are revenue options for local governments?

- 1 How are state governments reducing autonomy of local governments? (ties to Preemption category)
- 2 How are local governments being limited in lobbying efforts?
- 3 Who decides what services are provided by what levels of government?

d. State and Federal Preemption

- 1 What are the definitions today of preemption versus home rule?
- 2 What are the political implications of preemption?

- 4 How are state governments using efficiency commissions using preemption to promote efficiency?
- 5 What are the historical lessons learned from previous state and Federal preemption initiatives? How does preemption of authority by state legislatures impact local governments?
