Frequently Asked Questions

- Is this competition open to non-Fellows of the National Academy of Public Administration? Yes, it is open to all; Academy Fellows and others are encouraged to submit.
- 2. What is the balance between documenting a problem and developing actions, etc. to address it? The vast majority of the proposed work should focus on providing actionable solutions—suggested actions, steps, and plans.
- 3. What is the level of analysis federal, state, county, local, or other? Any level of government is acceptable.
- 4. What formats are acceptable for the roundtable? The roundtable is expected to be a public event, and the format may be in-person, hybrid, or virtual.
- 5. Who is responsible for generating the audience and promoting the roundtable? The Academy and Bridge Alliance will co-promote the event with the grantee; awardees are expected to promote through their professional networks.
- 6. **Can I propose deliverables in addition to those required in the RFP?** Yes, the RFP provides the minimum required deliverables. Additional deliverables are welcome.
- 7. Can I include hyperlinks in the text of my proposal? Yes.
- 8. What should I do if I don't know which category to submit my proposal under? You may submit to multiple categories; reviewers will align your proposal as needed.
- 9. **Do co-authors or collaborators need to be named and confirmed for the proposal?** You should list expected co-authors/collaborators; confirmation is not required, but participation should be likely.
- 10. What is the payment schedule? The stipend will be provided in two equal installments: 1st installment within 30 days of award (Jan/Feb), and 2nd installment in early July.
