1. Scope: This addendum covers the **Vehicle Lifts and Garage Associated Equipment** led by the State of Louisiana for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State *[or State Entity]* authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
2. Participation: This NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of Rhode Island. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

This Addendum shall be subject to the Rhode Island "State Purchases Act", R. I. Gen. Laws § 37-2-1, et seq., the Rhode Island Procurement Regulations and the Rhode Island General Conditions of Purchase (copy attached) except to the extent any of the foregoing conflicts with the provisions of this Addendum and/or Master Agreement.

Jurisdiction and venue for any lawsuits arising here from shall be in the Providence Superior Court and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Rhode Island without reference to its principles of conflicts of laws.

MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT CONTRACT ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

In 2017 the General Assembly amended the "State Purchases Act", R. I. Gen. Laws § 37-2-12 (b) to authorize the Chief Purchasing Officer to establish, charge and collect from vendors listed on master price agreements ("MPA") a contract administrative fee not to exceed one percent (1%) of the total value of the annual spend against their MPA contracts. All contract administrative fees collected from MPA vendors shall be deposited into a restricted receipt account which shall be used for the purposes of implementing and maintaining an online eProcurement system and other costs related to State procurement. In accordance with this legislative initiative the Division of Purchases is upgrading the State procurement system through the purchase and installation of an eProcurement system.

The contract administrative fee shall be applicable to all purchase orders issued relative to State MPA contracts. Therefore, effective January 1, 2020 all MPA contracts shall be assessed the 1% contract administrative fee.

5. Reports and Fees:

a) Administrative Fee: Contractor agrees to provide a quarterly administrative fee to the State in the form of a check, EFT or online payment through the Division's Automated Vendor Usage Management System. Checks will be payable to the "State of Rhode Island Division of Purchases" and will be sent to State of Rhode Island, Division of Purchasing, Attn: MPA Coordinator One Capitol Hill, Suite 201, Providence, RI 02908. The Administrative Fee will 1.0% and will apply to all purchases (net of any returns, credits, or adjustments) made under this Addendum.

b) Report Schedule: Quarterly utilization reports shall be made in accordance with the following schedule:

c) Timely Reports and Fees: Contractor will have thirty (30) days from the quarterly report due date to pay the quarterly administrative fee.

6. Lease Agreements: Section 4 as "Reserved".
7. Subcontractors: All contactors, dealers, and resellers authorized in the State of Rhode Island, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The contractor's dealer participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
8. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
9. Pricing and Discounts: Stertil-Koni pricing and discounts will be based off from NASPO Solicitation Number: 554414018. The NASPO member will work with the Stertil-Koni distributor in the member's territory to establish a fair and reasonable price for the Open Market item/s. Stertil-Koni's distributor will alert Stertil-Koni to the request and communicate the details to the NASPO end user (customer). The NASPO customer will add the agreed-upon Open Market item on the Purchase Order, which is submitted directly to Stertil-Koni. All shipping and delivery are FOB destination, at cost.
