2. Participation: This Addendum may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of *Rhode Island*. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

This Addendum shall be subject to the Rhode Island "State Purchases Act", R. I. Gen. Laws § 37-2-1, et seq., the Rhode Island Procurement Regulations and the Rhode Island General Conditions of Purchase (copy attached) except to the extent any of the foregoing conflicts with the provisions of this Addendum and/or Master Agreement.

Jurisdiction and venue for any lawsuits arising here from shall be in the Providence Superior Court and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Rhode Island without reference to its principles of conflicts of laws.

MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT CONTRACT ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

In 2017 the General Assembly amended the "State Purchases Act", R. I. Gen. Laws § 37-2-12 (b) to authorize the Chief Purchasing Officer to establish, charge and collect from vendors listed on master price agreements ("MPA") a contract administrative fee not to exceed one percent (1%) of the total value of the annual spend against their MPA contracts. All contract administrative fees collected from MPA vendors shall be deposited into a restricted receipt account which shall be used for the purposes of implementing and maintaining an online eProcurement system and other costs related to State procurement. In accordance with this legislative initiative the Division of Purchases is upgrading the State procurement system through the purchase and installation of an eProcurement system.

The contract administrative fee shall be applicable to all purchase orders issued relative to State MPA contracts. Therefore, effective January 1, 2020, all MPA contracts shall be assessed the 1% contract administrative fee.

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5. Lease Agreements: Section 4 as ***“Reserved”***.
 6. Subcontractors: All contactors, dealers, and resellers authorized in the State of *Rhode Island*, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The contractor's dealer participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
 7. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
 8. Design, Installation, and Reconfiguration Services: The Contractor shall provide, through their Authorized Dealer network, design, installation, layout, and reconfiguration services to Purchasing Entities. These service charges for all products offered through this Participating Addendum will be negotiated on a project-by-project basis with the Authorized Dealer. Installation and inside delivery charges will be included as a line item in the quote provided by the Authorized Dealer. Contractor shall provide, through their Authorized Dealer network or approved freight carrier(s) liftgate services and other non-standard delivery services which are outside of Contractor's standard freight costs, such as palletization, storage, special permits, etc.; should Contractor be able to accommodate the request, these services will be negotiated on a project-by-project basis and approved by the purchasing entity. Charges for non-standard delivery services will be included as a line item in the quote provided by the Authorized Dealer.
