This Participating Addendum is entered into by Contractor and Participating Entity (collectively, the "Parties").

Scope and Participation:1. Scope:

This Participating Addendum includes the entire scope of the products and services available through the Master Agreement PO-10700-00015859.

Any scope exclusions specified herein apply only to this Participating Addendum and shall not amend or affect other participating addendums or the Master Agreement itself.

2. Participation:

This Participating Addendum covers participation of Participating Entity in the above-referenced Master Agreement between the State of Oregon and Contractor for Parks and Recreation. Per KRS 45A.050(3), any political subdivision, including cities of all classes, counties, school districts, or special districts, may participate in this Participating Addendum to the same extent as the Commonwealth in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Participating Addendum. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation by such political subdivisions are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

3. Term:

This Participating Addendum shall become effective as of the date of October 1, 2023 and shall terminate December 31, 2023, with the option to renew through December 31, 2027, unless the Participating Addendum is terminated sooner or otherwise amended in accordance with the terms set forth herein.

Participating Entity Modifications and Additions to the Master Agreement

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This Participating Addendum incorporates all terms and conditions of the Master Agreement as applied to the Participating Entity and Contractor, **subject to the following limitations, modifications, and additions:**

The following changes are modifying or supplementing the Master Agreement terms and conditions.

A. Tax Exempt Status

Do not include Federal Excise Tax, Kentucky Sales or Use Tax in prices on invoices or quotations.

B. Provisions for Termination of the Contract

This contract shall be subject to the termination provisions set forth in 200 KAR 5:312.

C. Conflict of Interest

The parties certify by the signatures of duly authorized representatives hereinafter affixed, that they are legally entitled to enter into this agreement and that they shall not be violating, either directly or indirectly, any conflict of interest statute of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by the performance of this agreement.

D. Liability

The liability of the Commonwealth related to contractual damages is set forth in KRS 45A.245.

E. Payments

The vendor shall be paid, upon the submission of proper invoices to the receiving agency at the prices stipulated for the supplies delivered and accepted, or services rendered. Unless otherwise specified, payment will not be made for partial deliveries accepted. Payments will be made within thirty (30) working days after receipt of goods or a vendor's invoice in accordance with KRS 45.453 and KRS 45.454.

F. Governing Law

This contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Any action brought against the Commonwealth on the contract, including but not limited to actions either for breach of contract or for enforcement of the contract, shall be brought in Franklin Circuit Court, Franklin County, Kentucky in accordance with KRS 45A.245.

G. Access to Records

The state agency certifies that it is in compliance with the provisions of KRS 45A.695, "Access to contractor's books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence directly pertinent to the contract." The Contractor, as defined in KRS 45A.030, agrees that the contracting agency, the Finance and Administration Cabinet, the Auditor of Public Accounts, and the Legislative Research Commission, or their duly authorized representatives, shall have access to any books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence, which are directly pertinent to this agreement for the purpose of financial audit or program review. The Contractor also recognizes that any books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence, received during a financial audit or program review shall be subject to the Kentucky Open Records Act, KRS 61.870 to 61.884. Records and other prequalification information confidentially disclosed as part of the bid process shall not be deemed as directly pertinent to the agreement and shall be exempt from disclosure as provided in KRS 61.878(1)(c).

H. Contract Modification

No modification or change of any provision of this Agreement shall be made, or construed to be made, unless such modification is mutually agreed to in writing and the Office of Procurement Services has issued a contract Modification to effect the said change. Until such time as the vendor receives a Modification, the vendor shall not accept Delivery Orders from any agency referencing such items or services.

I. Vendor's Report

The vendor(s) may be asked to furnish the buyer, Office of Procurement Services, a report showing services provided to the Commonwealth and its using agencies each six (6) months of the contract period. The report will include political subdivisions and university purchases. This report may be the vendor's computer printout sheet or form. This shall apply to all services, which are to become a part of this contract. This report

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must reference usage by brief description of the services or other format designated by the Office of Procurement Services.

J. No Fees for Processing Credit Card Payments

The Contractor shall accept purchasing credit cards as a form of payment without charging any fees for the purchase.

K. Consolidated Quarterly Administrative Fee

The Contractor agrees to provide a quarterly administrative fee to the Commonwealth of Kentucky as part of the Contractor's prices for the services and is not to be charged directly to the customer in the form of a separate line item. The administrative fee percentage is only applicable to the Administrative Fee Components (as defined below) received by the Contractor for services hereunder. The administrative fee shall be paid in the form of a check payable to the Commonwealth of Kentucky – Office of Procurement Services for an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the Administrative Fee Components under this PA for the period. Fees shall be paid 60 days after the close of the quarter. Check to be mailed to the Office of Procurement Services, 200 Mero Street, 5th Floor, Frankfort, KY 40622.

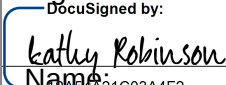

Participation of Contractor's contractors, dealers, and resellers will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Master Agreement.
6. **Orders:** Any order placed by Participating Entity or a Purchasing Entity for a product or service offered through this Participating Addendum shall be deemed to be a sale under, and subject to the pricing and other terms and conditions of, the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to the order.
