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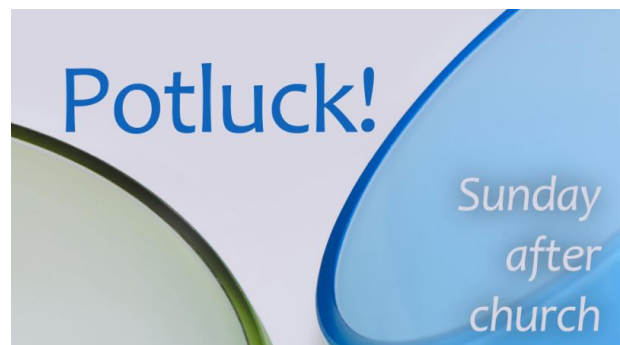

She and her friends are already preparing for their 78th reunion.

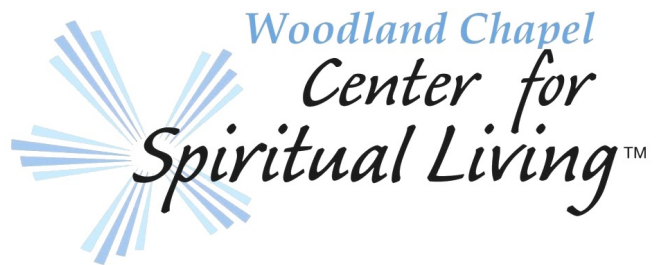
