Domestic Scrapping Bonus Program

Follow the steps to receive your scrapping bonus:

- **STEP 1:** You must first apply for the Domestic Scrapping Bonus Program to check your eligibility. To be eligible for the program, your pre-2007 engine truck must have entered a Northwest Seaport Alliance international or domestic container terminal in 2019. NWSA verifies this information using the truck's VIN and license plate number.
- **STEP 2:** Once the NWSA approves your application, you must scrap your pre-2007 truck at an approved scrap yard*. You are responsible for contacting the scrap yard and making an appointment. The scrapping process can take up to 1 week.
- **STEP 3** After your truck is scrapped, the scrap yard will provide documentation and photographs to the NWSA confirming your pre-2007 truck has been properly destroyed.
- **STEP 4:** You are responsible for finding and purchasing a suitable replacement truck. If you replace your old truck with a 2016 Model Year (MY) or newer truck, you could be eligible for up to a \$20,000 scrapping bonus up to 50% of the cost of your new truck.
- **STEP 5:** The NWSA will issue your scrapping bonus after it receives all documentation (proof of scrapping <u>AND</u> proof of purchase of a replacement truck).
