MACEDC supports key initiatives that build and strengthen our economy and those partners that make our economy grow and thrive. For these reasons, we are grateful to provide a letter of support for The Northwest Seaport Alliance's (NWSA) FY25 grant application for the Port Infrastructure Development Program for the Terminal 18 Efficiency Project.

One of MACEDC's key pillars of focus is economic development, and as part of that effort, we own a premier inland intermodal facility in Minot, ND.
