

The Port of Seattle Police Department provides the primary law enforcement service at The Northwest Seaport Alliance properties in Seattle. The port police are the primary first responders for all reported crimes and incidents and enforce parking and traffic regulations within its jurisdiction.

Speed limit is 10 mph on all Seattle harbor facilities unless otherwise posted.

# **TWIC Requirements**

A Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) is required for all Port employees, terminal operators, longshore workers, truckers and others who require regular, unescorted access to Northwest Seaport Alliance restricted areas (i.e. marine terminals) and vessels. To access restricted Port-operated facilities, non-TWIC holders must be accompanied by a person who has been issued a TWIC and trained as an escort. Leased NWSA terminals have their own access quidelines.

# **MARSEC Security Levels**

MARSEC security levels reflect the prevailing terrorist threat environment to the marine transportation system, including ports, vessels, facilities and other critical marine infrastructure. When entering a Port restricted area, you will see a sign that identifies the current MARSEC level. At any time, one of three different MARSEC levels is in effect (I, II, or III). Higher levels may result in delays.

MARSEC I – the level for which minimum appropriate security measures shall be maintained always.

MARSEC II – appropriate protective security measures shall be maintained for a period of time due to a heightened risk of a transportation security incident.

MARSEC III – further protective security measures shall be maintained for a limited period of time when a transportation security incident is probable, imminent, or has occurred, although it may not be possible to identify the specific target.

#### U.S. Customs

U.S. Customs officials may inspect your container load, either manually or using the most current technology. The vehicle-mounted VACIS and Radiation Portal Monitors (RPMs) are non-intrusive inspection technology that scans containers to identify items such as explosives, drugs or weapons of mass destruction. The scans help ensure that your load is legal and safe for transport.

# REGIONAL MAP Seattle and Tacoma Harbors







The information listed below is needed for delivery or pick-up of cargo. Make appointments via the terminal operator's approved scheduling system. Multi-company haulers must state the name of the company for which they are hauling. Confirm container availability and/or whether vessel is open for receiving prior to arriving at the terminal.

# Required for all Transactions

- TWIC card (a list of approved TWIC escorts is available upon request)
- Valid driver's license
- Truck license number and state of registration
- Truck company name and SCAC code
- Truck/tractor weight (lbs.)
- Trailer/chassis/flatbed weight (lbs.). Include the weight of Genset if it is your own
- Clean Truck registration (RFID tag)
- PPE (safety vest)

Additional information may be required depending on transaction. Appointments and pre-arrivals are scheduled via eModal.

- Container number
- Schedule appointments for cargo in RTG rows at T18

# **Export Cargo Drop-off**

- Booking number
- Seal number
- Commodity, temp settings (for reefer cargo)

# **Empty Pick-up**

# **Empty Drop-off**

- Container free of cargo, trash, and placards
- Schedule pre-arrival at T18 and T30

#### Chassis

- Match the correct chassis for the move: TPNP, DCLI, or SSCO
- Bare TPNP chassis require a booking number. Go to www.tracconnect.com and click EZ-book in the top right corner

# Clean Truck Program

The Northwest Seaport Alliance (NWSA) Clean Truck Program requires all drayage trucks entering NWSA international container terminals in both the Seattle and Tacoma Harbors to have an RFID tag and a 2007 (or newer) engine, or a certified equivalent emission control system. Clean Truck Program requirements reduce diesel particulate matter emissions by up to 90 percent per truck.

Your RFID tag must be registered with current truck and driver information at <a href="https://www.emodal.com">www.emodal.com</a>. While RFID tags are required on all compliant trucks, individual terminals may use green stickers when gates are experiencing downtime.

# **Heavy Haul Network**

The Heavy Haul Network (HHN) in the Seattle Harbor allows qualified loads more than the legal weight limit to be transported on city streets between intermodal facilities and marine terminals.

Use of the HHN requires a special permit. Permits can be obtained from the City of Seattle Department of Transportation, Traffic Permits/Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division. A Commercial Vehicle Safety inspection will be required as part of the application process.

- I-5 NB & SB over King-Jackson St 20,000 lbs. per axle weight limit for BL & CL-8. Traffic from I-90 not carried
- I-5 NB & SB on the Broadway Ave Over-Ramps 21,500 lbs. per axle weight limit for BL & 43,500 lbs. weight limit for SA. This bridge crosses over ramps, not on the I-5 mainline.
