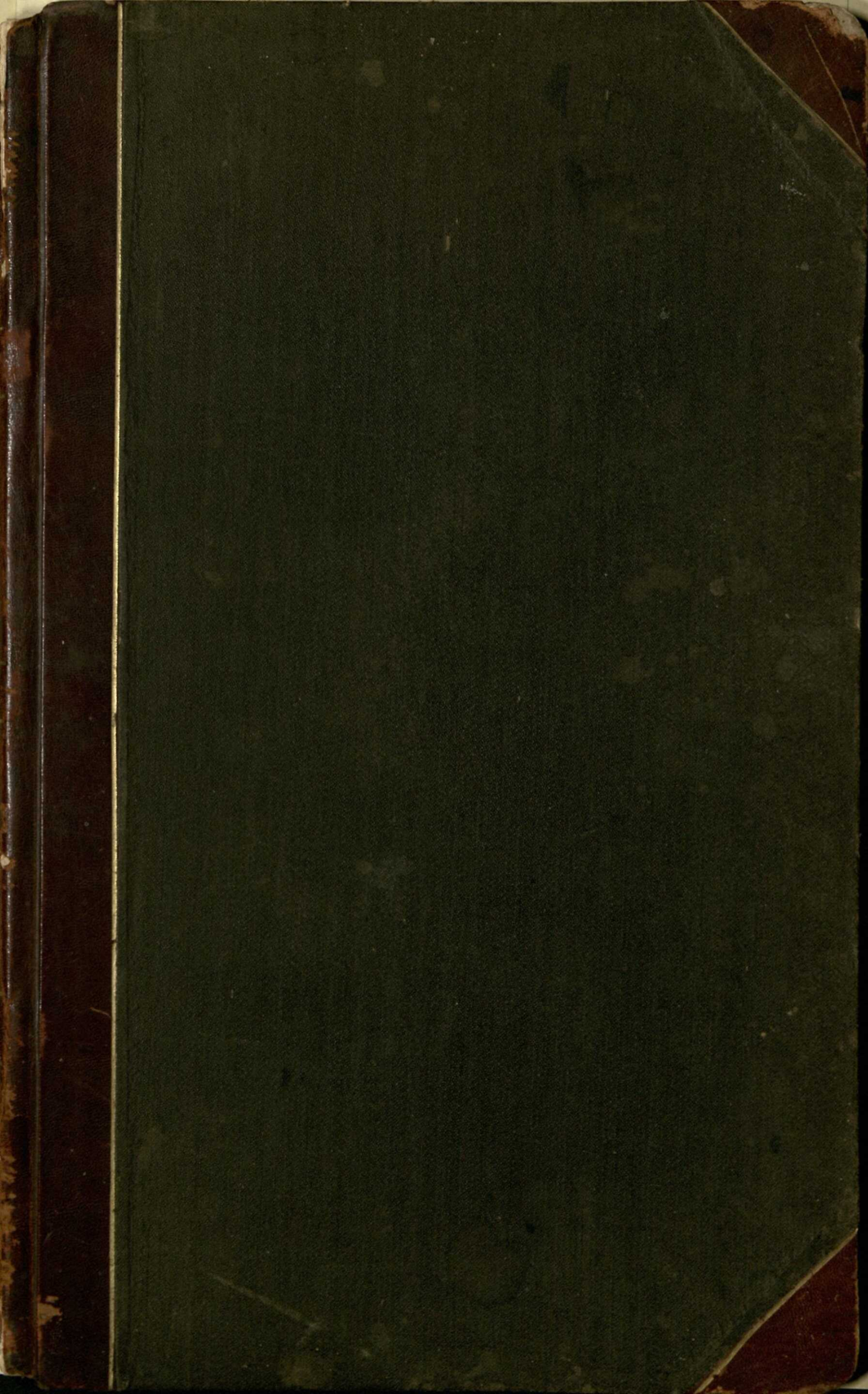

We the undersigned Elds and deacons called to form a presbytery met the Brethren and sisters at the home of Bro L. V. Skogin. Met James D. Strickland, L. S. Skogin Lyarel, Gray A. G. Morton Nancy M. Skogin Saravann Gray and Jane Strickland. and upon examination found them to be orthodox and in order delivered them the following constitution and Church Covenant and pronounced them a Church by the name of Emmanuel Elds G W Thompson H. G. Fuller. Deacons Bro. Thomas. A. J. Wornack

Rules of Government for Emmanuel Church

Our Preacher shall be our moderator when in order when absent shall choose one

- 1.st is Invite visiting Brethren and sisters of our faith and order to seats with us
- 2.nd Enquire for the fellowship of the Church
- 3.rd Open the door of the Church for reception of members
- 4.th for reference 5.th for General Business
- 6.th Every motion made and seconded shall be put to the Church unless withdrawn by the mover
- 7.th All Cases shall be decided by the majority of the Church only in case of fellowship which shall be unanimous
- 8.th It shall be the duty of every male member to attend Conference and if they miss 2 Conferences shall tell their reasons
- 9.th Every member who speaks shall rise from his seat and address the moderator and shall not cast reflections on any Bro who spoke before him and the appellation of Bro shall be used in all our deliberations. and the Moderator shall have the same rite of speech as any other Bro provided the Chair be filled
- 10.th Amendments may be made to these rules at any time the Church see proper

Constitution

- 1st We believe in only one true and living God and that there is a trinity of persons in the God head the Father Son and holy ghost and yet there are not three Gods, but one God
- 2nd We believe that the Scriptures of the old and New Testaments are the words of God and the only rule of faith and practice
- 3rd We believe in the fall of Adam and the imputation of sin to his posterity in the corruption of human nature, and the impotency of Man to recover him self of his own free will abilities
- 4th We believe in the everlasting love of God to his people and the eternal election of a definite number of the human race to grace and glory and that there was a covenant of grace or redemption between the father and son before the world began in which their salvation is secure and that they in particular are redeemed
- 5th We believe that sinners are justified in the sight of God only by the righteousness of Christ imputed to them
- 6th We believe all those who were chosen in Christ will be effectually called regenerated converted sanctified and supported by the spirit and power of God so that they will persevere in grace and not one of them be finally lost
- 7th we believe that good works are the fruits of faith and follow after justification and that they only justify us in the sight of men and angels and are evidences of our gracious state
- 8th We believe that there will be a resurrection of the dead and a general judgment and the happiness of the righteous and the punishment of the wicked will be eternal
- 9th We believe that no minister has the right to the administration of the ordinances only such as are regularly called and come under the imposition of hands by the presbytery
- 10th We believe that the Georgia Baptist Convention the missionary Bible tract Sunday School Union and Temperance societies together with the Theological seminaries and other kindred institutions falsely called benevolent are unscriptural unsupported by divine revelation and therefore improper and we believe that no individual who is united with or are the advocates of all or either of them should be held in fellowship by our churches

1st

We believe that the visible Church of Christ is a Congregation of faithful persons that have given themselves to the Lord and to one another in the name of the Lord and has agreed to keep up a godly discipline in the name of the Lord

2nd

We believe that Jesus Christ is the head of the Church and the only lawgiver and that the government is upon his shoulders and that the discipline of the Church is with the Body and is intended for the reclaiming of those members that may be disorderly either in principle or practice.

3rd

We believe the gift of the ministry is intended for the edifying of the Body and for the calling in of his sons from afar and his daughters from the ends of the earth that the visible Church upon earth shall be complete and there shall be one fold and one shepherd

4th

We believe it to be the duty of the Church to support and approve and encourage a sound ministry and also cry down and disapprove an unsound and disorderly one

5th

We the Emmons Church do Covenant and agree to live together as faithful Brethren and Sisters being of the same family - possessing the same principles and faith upon the above written abstract of faith and Church Covenant
