The California Teamsters Public, Professional and Medical Employees Union, Local No. 911 is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for all certified regular, extra board, and part-time Coach Operators employed by the Orange County Transit District who provide regular fixed route service, excluding all other drivers in demand-activated service (like or similar to "Dial-A-Ride" service) and excluding all other employees, office clerical employees, professional employees, mechanics and maintenance employees, guards and supervisors and all drivers employed by private sector contractors.
