DECISION

This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) as a request for reconsideration of the Board's decision in <u>California State Employees' Association (Dees)</u> (1985) PERB Decision No. 496-H. We find that Charging Party has failed to assert a valid basis for reconsideration and thus find no reason to disturb our underlying decision to dismiss the instant charge. Having so concluded, we also reject Charging Party's request that this case be consolidated with another case filing presently before the Board.¹
