DECISION AND ORDER

HESSE, Chairperson: This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) on exceptions filed by the State of California (Department of Personnel Administration) (State) and cross-exceptions filed by the Union of American Physicians and Dentists (UAPD) to a proposed decision of a PERB administrative law judge which held that the State violated section 3519(c) of the Ralph C. Dills Act (Dills Act) by failing and refusing to bargain in good faith with UAPD.

Subsequent to these filings, the State and UAPD requested that the exceptions and cross-exceptions be withdrawn. The Board has considered the requests of withdrawal and concurs that

withdrawal is in the best interest of the parties and is consistent with the purposes of the Dills Act.

It is hereby ORDERED that the exceptions and cross-exceptions filed to the proposed decision in Case No. SF-CE-96-S are WITHDRAWN WITH PREJUDICE.
