## DECISION

CARLYLE, Member: This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) on an appeal filed by Mary McFarland (McFarland) to a Board agent's partial dismissal of her charge that the Washington Teachers Association (Association) violated section 3543.6(b) of the Educational Employment Relations Act (EERA or Act). The Association filed a response in opposition to the appeal. Subsequent to the filings, McFarland in accordance with a settlement agreement with the Association, requested that the appeal be withdrawn. The Board has considered the request and concurs that such a withdrawal is in the best interest of the parties and is consistent with the Act.
