Dear Mr. Godfrey:

As you know, the Covina-Valley Unified School District contests the 30% showing of support submitted by your organization in its intervention. I have completed a review of all the material submitted by AFT and I find that there is a total of 156 names that could be considered acceptable out of a necessary 173 to 183.

The range of 173 to 183 is due to the inclusion of adult school teachers, some of whom have signed the petition. Adult school teachers of less than full-time signed your petition, so it appears that they are also included in the AFT unit. Since your claimed unit did not exclude any adult school teachers, the unit size would be approximately 609. A valid intervention would require at least 182.70 signatures. This letter serves as notification that your organization has failed to meet that requirement.

Any party may obtain a review of this action by filing an appeal to the Board itself, 923 12th Street, Sacramento, CA 95814, to the attention of Charles Cole, Executive Director. The appeal shall be in writing, signed by the party or its agent and shall contain facts and arguments upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be accompanied by proof of service of the document on each party.
