Pursuant to Califormia Govemment Code Section 3540 et. seq., the Pegional Director of the Ecucational Employment Relations Eoard hereby orders an Election, the provisions of which are as follows:

1. Jurisaiction. The Erployer is a public school employer within the meaning of the Act; and any eployee organization nared below is an erployee organization within the meaning of the f.ct; and the employees described in the appropriate unit are public school employees within the meaning of the Act.

2: Election. An election by secret ballot shall be held under the supervision of the Educational Employment Relations Eoard Fegional Director, among the employees of the employer designated above in the unit defined below, at the indicated time and place, to detemine whether or not such epployees desire to be represented for the purpose of meeting and negotiating by (one of) the employee organization(s) designated below. The election shall be held in accordance with SB 160 and the applicable nules and regulations and procedures of the frra.
3. Voter Eligibility. The eligible voters shall be those employees within the unit described beicw wo were enployed or the eligibility cutoff date indicated below, including employees who dia not work during said period because they were ill or on vacation, leave of absence, sabbatical or temporarily laid off or erpioyees in the military services of the United States who appear in person at the poll, and who are employed on the date of the election.
4. $\therefore$ Voter Lists: At a date set by the Regional Director the employer shall fumish to the Regional Director an accurate list of all the eligible voters. The list shall be in alphabetical order by polling location,
-5. Notice of Election. The Regional Director shall prepare a Notice of Election and supply copies to the parties describing the manner and conduct of the election to be held and incorcomating therein a sample ballot. The parties, upon the reguest of and at.a time designated by the Regional Director, will post such Notice of Election conspicuously on all employee bulletin buards in each facility of the employer in which merbers of. the mit are employed.

6: Observers. Each party will be alloved to station an equal number of authorized observers selected from the normanagerent, nonsupervisory erployees of the enployer at the polling places during the election to assist in its conduct, to challenge the eligibility of voters, and to verify the Tally of Eallots. If the unit consists of supervisory employees the parties may designate supervisors as observers.
7. Tally of pallots. As scon after the election as feasible, the ballots sinall. be mingled and counted at the location designated below and tabulated by the Regional Director or the Regional Director's desigmated agent. Upon the conclusion of the counting, the Regional Director or cesignated agent shall furnish a Tally of Ballots to each of the parties.

8: Objections and Fostelection Procezures. Objections to the conduct of the election or conduct affecting the results of the election, or to a determination of representatives based on the results thereof, may be filed with the Regional Director within 7 calendar days after receipt of the Tally of Eallots. Copies of such objections must be served upon the other parties at the time of filing with the Regional Director. All other procedures suiosequent to the conclusion of counting of ballots and issuance of Tally of Ballots shall be in conformity with the EERB's fules and Regulations.
9. Punpff Elections. In the event a nunoff election is necessary, it shall be run at the diretion of the Pegional Director.
10. Right of Appeal. Any party may obtain a review of the provisions of this Directred Election cader by filing an appeal with the bard itself through the Executive Director, within 10 calendar days of the date of this order. A cofy of the appeal should be served upon each of the other parties. The appeal should contain a couplete statement setting forth the facts and reasons upon wich it is based.
11. Wording on Eallot. Were only one erolovee organization is party to this Agrement, the nart of the eployoe organization shall appear on the ballot in addition to the desimation "N REPRESETMTICN." In the event that more than one employee organization is party to this Agrecment. the choices on the ballot shall appear in the wording and orcer enmerated below, reading from left to right on the ballot, or if necessary, from top to bottom.

First: united teachers of los angeles
Second: NO REPRESENTATION

18. Special Provisions.

1. Each party will be allowed to station one observer at each polling site.
2. Absentee Ballots are to be provided to eligible voters on leave of absence (excluding position leaves) whose names and home accresses are provided to the EERB Regional Office by December 14, 1975. Said ballots are to be mailed by the EFRB no later than January 1.2, 1977, and must be received by the Regional Office no later than 5 p.m. on January 27, 1977, in order to be counted.
