Dear Sirs:

It has been determined that an impasse does exist and your case has been referred to a state mediator who will be contacting both parties shortly to set up an initial meeting. Investigation of the matter established that nineteen (19) meetings have taken place over a period of seven (7) months with several major areas yet to be resolved and no further meetings scheduled. We have decided that the help of a mediator at this time would facilitate the bargaining process.

An appeal to this decision may be made within ten (10) calendar days of receipt of this letter, stating the facts upon which the appeal is based and filed with the Executive Director, Mr. Charles Cole, at 923 12th Street, Suite 200, Sacramento, California 95814. Copies of any appeal must be served upon all other parties to this action with additional copy to the San Francisco Regional Office.
