## DECISION

The United Public Employees, Local 390, SEIU, AFL-CIO, appeals the regional director's determination that a tie vote in an organizational security election conducted in the San Ramon Valley Unified School District is determinative of the outcome; that the organization has failed to record a majority vote favoring a negotiated organizational security provision as required by section 3546(a) of the Educational Employment Relations Act; that the

organizational security provision shall not be implemented and that no "run-off" election may be ordered.

The regional director's determination is APPROVED.
