DECISION AND ORDER

CAMILLI, Member: The California Union of Safety Employees (CAUSE) filed a request for reconsideration with the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) following the issuance of PERB Order No. Ad-191-S, which held that a severance petition filed by the California State Peace Officers Association (CSPOA) was timely filed. Thereafter, CSPOA withdrew the underlying severance petition in this matter. Subsequently, CAUSE filed a request to withdraw the request for reconsideration pending before the Board. The Board has considered the request for withdrawal and concurs that a withdrawal is in the best interest of the parties and is consistent with the purposes of the Ralph

C. Dills Act (Gov. Code sections 3512 et. seq.). Accordingly, the Board grants CAUSE's request to withdraw its request for reconsideration.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request for reconsideration in Case No. S-S-124-S is WITHDRAWN WITH PREJUDICE.
