DECISION

McKEAG, Member: This case comes before the Public Employment Relations Board

(Board) on appeal by the California State University Employees Union (CSUEU) of a

dismissal of a petition for unit modification (petition). The petition sought the transfer of

positions held by six (6) employees in the Unit 6 Facilities Series to the Unit 5 Grounds Series.

The petition alleged that these positions "evolved" over time from skilled trades to ground

works and are no longer appropriate to their current unit.

By letter dated November 14, 2006, CSUEU requested to withdraw its appeal of the dismissal of the petition.

Having reviewed the record in this matter, the Board finds a withdrawal to be in the best interests of the parties and consistent with the purposes of the Higher Education Employer-Employee Relations Act.¹ Accordingly, the Board grants

request to

withdraw its appeal.

ORDER

The request by the California State University Employees Union to withdraw its appeal of the dismissal in Case No. LA-UM-763-H is hereby GRANTED.
