

The Port of Tacoma has an immediate opening for a Temporary Journey Level Carpenter.

This is a non-benefited, represented, non-exempt position expected to last up to three (3) months. This position is responsible for performing skilled work in construction, maintenance and repair, preventative maintenance renovation and tenant improvements of commercial buildings, offices, garages, warehouses, piers and wharfs. Work includes carpentry, general facilities maintenance, painting, roofing and other related duties as assigned.

Essential Functions and Duties:

- Troubleshoot, inspect, repair and service port assets and tenant improvements, conduct proactive maintenance to ensure facilities are at optimal levels.
- Read and interpret blueprints, schematics, and service manuals.
- Assist with estimating labor and materials and researching parts.
- Enter work order data on the computerized maintenance management system and on handwritten documents.
- Perform related duties as assigned.

Required Experience and Education:

Minimum education is a High School Diploma, GED or equivalent. Education beyond High School and trade school training preferred.

Minimum of five (5) years' experience performing a variety of skilled facilities maintenance work such as carpentry, roofing, and tenant improvements. Must have First Aid/CPR training and must maintain a valid Washington State driver's license.

Must be willing to work any shift including overtime. Field responsibilities include walking, climbing, bending, crouching, and being exposed to various outside noise, heights, and weather conditions. Must be able to lift up to fifty (50) pounds.
