Growing sales are the lifeblood of any business. Thanks to Bozeman entrepreneurs Jonathan Distad and Peg Rifleman there are Customer Relationship Management (CRM) systems in place to help sales folks be successful. Jonathan and Peg consult with and train companies on ways to optimize the Salesforce CRM platform to help out-sell the competition.

When Jonathan and Peg chose Bozeman to start Zinovo, they immediately got connected to Prospera as new members to help get started. Working together, Zinovo, Prospera and the City of Bozeman successfully received a business development grant for \$70,000 that will support Zinovo hiring 14 new full-time employees.

Zinovo chose Bozeman because of its reputation for supporting similar businesses, and having access to highly-skilled workers. And Jonathan, who grew up in NW Montana, loved the idea of raising his family in Montana.




