⁸ Therefore do not be ashamed of **either** the **witness about¹** our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God, ⁹ **who saved²** us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was **given to³** us in Christ Jesus from all eternity, ¹⁰ but has now been **manifested⁴** by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, ¹¹ for which I was appointed a preacher, **an⁵** apostle, and a teacher. ¹² For this reason I also suffer these things; but I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed, and I am convinced that He is able to **guard⁶** what I have entrusted to Him until that day. ¹³ **Hold to⁷** the standard of sound words which you have heard from me, in *the* faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. ¹⁴ Guard, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us, the treasure which has been entrusted to *you*.
