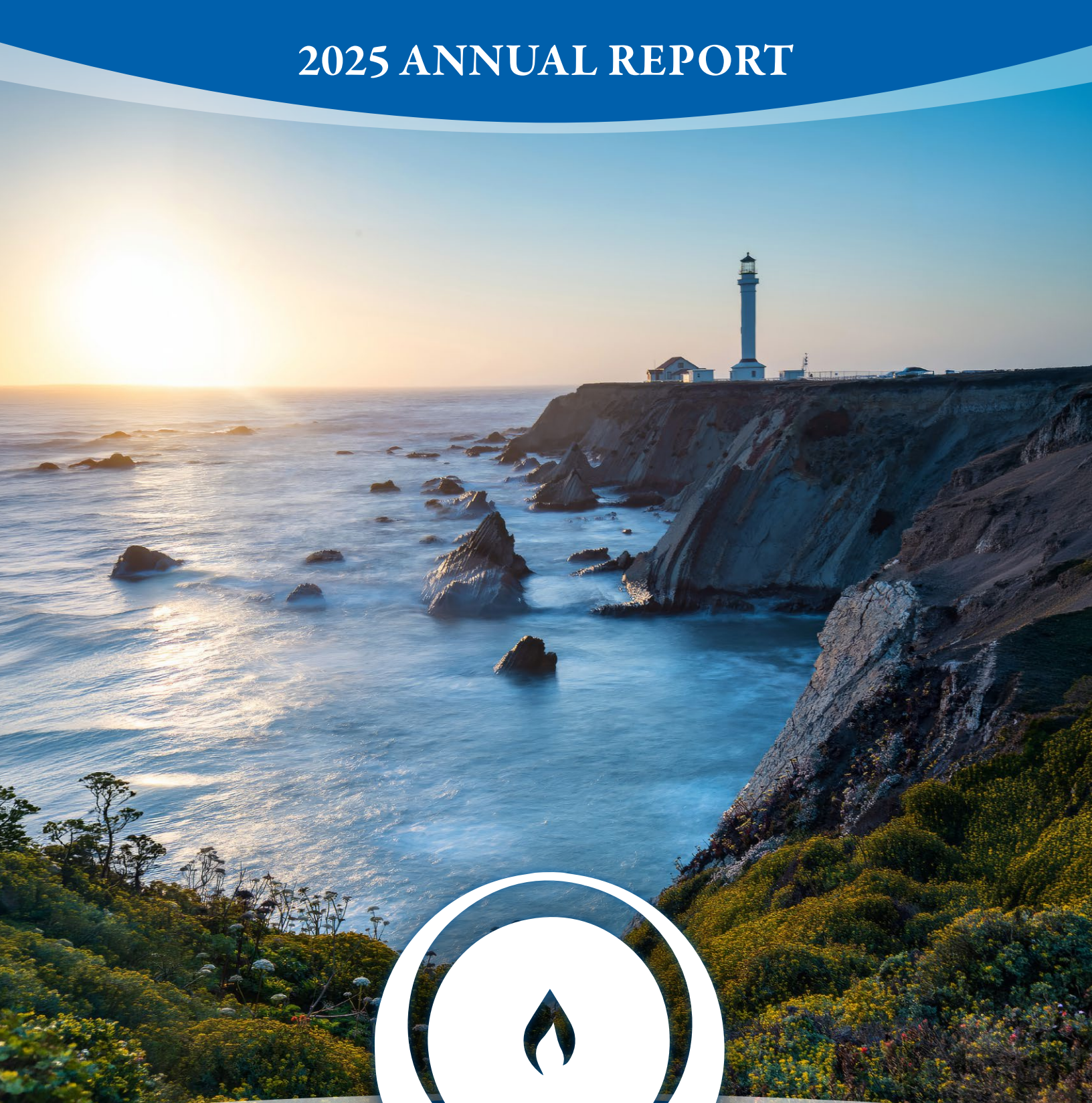

Message from our Executive Director



Dear Friend,

Because of your partnership, 2025 became one of the most consequential years in the four decade history of the Romero Institute.

This organization has taken on systems of secrecy, abuse of power, and structural injustice — often long before the public or political will existed to confront them. In 2025, that long arc converged with the need to reveal 80 years of unlawful secrecy concerning UFO/UAP programs and the constitutional crisis it represents.

Through the New Paradigm Institute, you helped transform disclosure from a marginalized topic into a serious legal, legislative, and moral issue at the highest levels of government. This year, a House Oversight Task Force with subpoena power was established. Whistleblowers stepped forward in growing numbers. Senior officials within the Department of Justice and federal law enforcement engaged with our legal strategy. Millions of people encountered rigorous, fact-based analysis through our events, publications, and media. Just as important, 2025 marked a shift in how disclosure is being pursued. No longer framed as speculation or belief, our work now centers on constitutional authority, congressional oversight, and accountability under the law. The question is no longer whether Congress has the power to compel disclosure — it does. The question is whether that power will be fully exercised.

At the same time, our grassroots movement, Citizens for Disclosure, grew into a disciplined national force. Volunteers across the country met directly with their elected leaders, organized locally, and applied sustained constituent pressure where it matters most. Public engagement reached a new level with our Global Disclosure online event and dozens of in-person community viewings of *The Age of Disclosure*, transforming curiosity into collective action.

All of this work — legal research, policy development, organizing, education, and public mobilization — was made possible by you. Your support allowed us to build the professional capacity, infrastructure, and momentum required to move toward enforcement, not just advocacy.

As you read this report, you'll see a year defined by preparation and resolve. The path ahead will demand courage, resources, and persistence. But the foundation has been laid. The stakes are high and promise a leap in our consciousness, solutions to climate change, clean inexpensive sources of energy, ending pollution while renewing our planet, and human collaboration replacing endless wars and the nuclear threat. Together we can birth a new age, a positive future for humanity on our living beautiful, blue and green planet, Earth.

Thank you for standing with us in this historic moment.

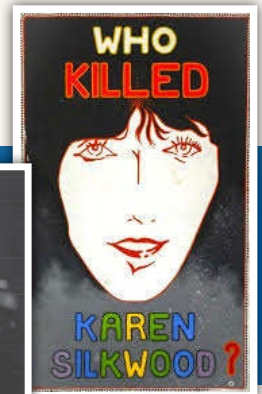
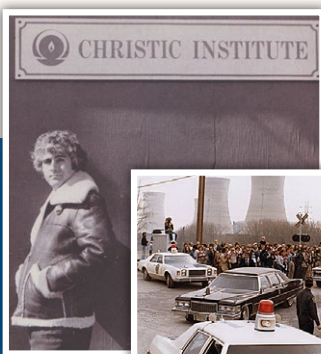
Founded 1981

Descended from the Christic Institute and home of the New Paradigm Institute and Let's Green CA!, we defend human rights and the Earth. For more than 50 years, our leaders have been guardians and advocates for the people. Through public education, grassroots organizing, leadership development, research, investigation, impact litigation, and forward-thinking public policy, we take action where our objectives have the potential for large-scale impact. Our History



Daniel Sheehan, Esq.

A Harvard-trained constitutional law attorney, Daniel Sheehan, Esq. serves as the Romero Institute's president, chief council, architect of public policy, and primary spokesperson. Daniel has led or participated in some of the most important public interest cases of the last 50 years, including the Watergate and Iran-Contra Scandals, the Pentagon Papers, and the killing of Karen Silkwood. Known for leading groundbreaking professional investigations, strategic lawsuits, and disclosing hidden secrets and crimes, he has led cases that set precedents and won victories for birth control availability, the civil rights of African American leaders, Central American immigrants, women and labor leaders, Native American leaders, doctors and nurses, prisoners, military leaders, environmentalists and peace advocates, nuclear safety whistleblowers and organizers, and religious leaders. Three of his cases won rights in the Supreme Court for journalists, movie producers, labor leaders, environmentalists, and all citizens.

Sara Nelson, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Sara Nelson is the executive director and co-founder of the Romero Institute, and its predecessor, the Christic Institute. A former TV reporter, news anchor and N.O.W. feminist leader, she played a pivotal role in the nationwide Karen Silkwood campaign, leading to a \$10.5 million legal judgment and halting new private nuclear plant construction for over 30 years. Sara led a series of national disclosure and justice campaigns, most importantly the Iran Contra Campaign to expose the crimes of the “Secret Government” or the Off the Shelf Enterprise. Knowing that humans can solve big problems if they have access to the truth, she co-founded the Romero Institute to address environmental and human rights issues, continuing her lifelong commitment to social justice and positive systemic change.

2025 Highlight: People of the Americas Unite

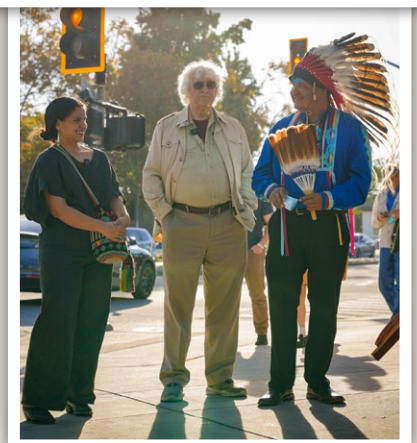
In 2025, the Romero Institute hosted **People of the Americas Unite**, a public gathering that brought together community members, organizers, artists, and legal advocates to affirm solidarity across borders in North and Central America and advance the struggle for immigrant justice and human rights throughout the Americas.

The event, attended by 350, was a combination of rally, forum, and concert. It included a recorded message from **Dolores Huerta** and remarks from **Daniel Sheehan**, **Camila Chavez**, and **Chase Iron Eyes** (Iron Eyes is the executive director of the Lakota People’s Law Project, a former Romero Institute program for 20 years). The gathering included a musical performance by internationally recognized artist **Poranguí**.

The program highlighted the shared struggles of Indigenous peoples, migrant communities, and frontline organizers, emphasizing the enduring importance of constitutional protections, human dignity, and collective action.

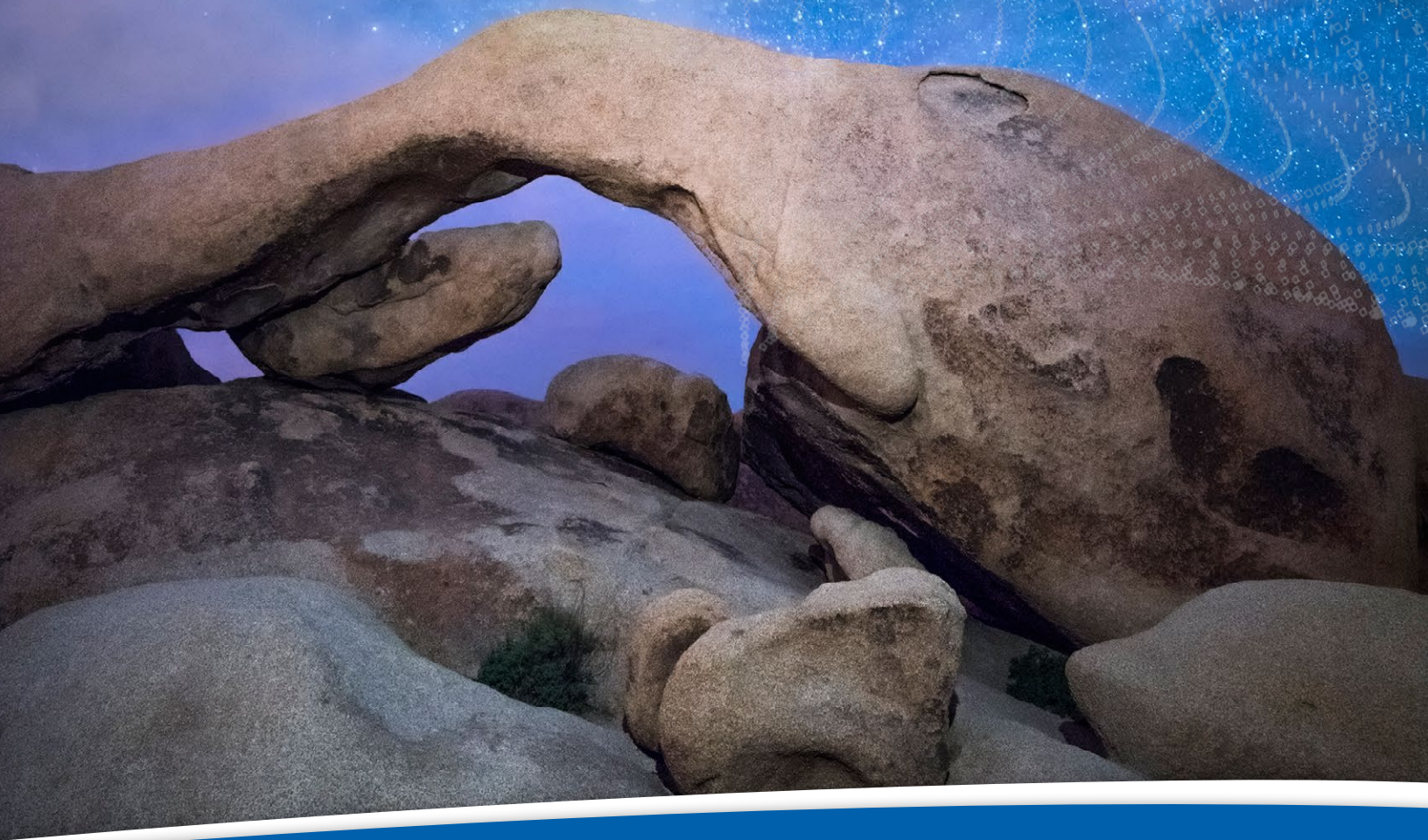
At the present moment when the country remains deeply divided and democratic values are under

NEW PARADIGM INSTITUTE

In 2025, the **New Paradigm Institute** (NPI), emerged as a driving force in the national and global movement for truth, transparency, and disclosure regarding Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena (UAP), or what is commonly known as Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs). Thanks to the generous support of the Romero Institute's members and donors, we achieved remarkable growth across all fronts—policy advocacy, public engagement, communications, and education. Simply put, NPI would not be where it is today without the belief and backing of this community.

Our mission

remains unwavering: to compel full and responsible UAP disclosure from governments, private and public entities, and individuals, while preparing humanity for the societal transformations that will come with undeniable evidence of contact with non-human intelligence. Looking back on 2025, we are proud to report substantial progress in fulfilling that mission.

A Turning Point Year

During 2025, the following key inflection points occurred:

- The establishment of a House Oversight Task Force in the Congress on the Declassification of Federal Secrets, vested with subpoena authority;
- Increased public testimony in Congress via public hearings and cooperation from UAP whistleblowers;
- Direct engagement between NPI's legal team and senior officials within the Department of Justice and federal law enforcement;
- A measurable shift in congressional willingness to treat UAP secrecy as a matter of constitutional concern.

IN 2025 NPI ENTERED A NEW PHASE OF ITS WORK



What began as an effort to break the silence has evolved into a coordinated national campaign focused on accountability, enforcement, and democratic oversight. This year marked a decisive shift: disclosure is no longer a question of if, but of how.

Advancing Disclosure, Accountability, and Constitutional Oversight

Founded by constitutional attorney Daniel Sheehan, the New Paradigm Institute (NPI) is the Romero Institute's flagship initiative dedicated to 1) ending unlawful secrecy related to UFOs (now called Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena [UAP]), 2) protecting whistleblowers, and 3) restoring congressional authority over classified government programs that contain decades of information on breakthrough physics, energy sources, antigravity mechanisms, and propulsion technology that could be the basis of a golden age of clean, low-cost energy.

This secret information also contains information about advanced, nonhuman intelligence that may constitute civilizations billions of years older than ours. They've said "you humans do not know what you're capable of", suggesting we may have innate capacities that only a few humans (e.g. "mystics") display.

For more than 80 years, information concerning UAP has been withheld not only from the public, but from Congress, the origin of all federal authority. NPI exists to change that — through legal action, strategic organizing, rigorous investigation, and sustained public engagement.

Citizens for Disclosure

Building Strategic Grassroots Power

NPI's grassroots organizing arm, Citizens for Disclosure (CfD), experienced dramatic growth and maturation in 2025.

What began as a broad-based mobilization effort evolved into a disciplined, outcome-driven network capable of creating sustained legislative pressure.

2025 CfD Highlights

- Expanded to 23 active states with trained coordinators and leadership teams;
- Hosted hundreds of volunteer-led congressional meetings nationwide;
- Held regular advocacy trainings, state chapter meetings, and coordinated national calls;
- Created standardized messaging, organizing tools, and onboarding systems.

In the final quarter of the year, CfD shifted toward a targeted national strategy, concentrating constituent pressure on key members of the House Oversight Committee in states critical to advancing a standalone UFO Disclosure bill.

400+ Congressional meetings held

Legal & Policy Leadership

In 2025, NPI advanced its legal strategy to compel disclosure and accountability.

Under the leadership of President & Chief Counsel Daniel Sheehan, NPI:

- Continued development of a federal criminal RICO complaint targeting principal actors within the unlawful UFO Legacy Program;
- Collaborated with whistleblowers, investigators, and federal insiders to assemble evidentiary foundations for formal investigation;
- Conducted extensive constitutional research to support new standalone UFO Disclosure legislation, grounded in Congress's existing investigative and oversight powers;

This work laid the groundwork for professional investigation and litigation planned for future years.

Building Strategic Grassroots Power

NPI's most ambitious public-facing initiative to date, Global Disclosure Day 2025 featured a four-hour live program combining expert panels, legal analysis, historical context, and forward-looking strategy — reaching more than 20,000 viewers worldwide.

Community-Based Organizing

Building on this momentum, NPI supported 60 in-person watch parties nationwide for the documentary film *The Age of Disclosure*, transforming digital engagement into local community-building and organizing.

Congressional Engagement

NPI significantly expanded its direct presence on Capitol Hill in 2025.

NPI staff, legal leadership, & trained volunteers:

- Conducted hundreds of meetings with Members of Congress and senior staff;
- Engaged key committees including House Oversight, Intelligence, Homeland Security, and Science & Technology;
- Educated congressional offices on the legal, constitutional, and national security implications of UAP secrecy;
- Prepared lawmakers for upcoming legislative and investigative action.

Digital & Media Reach

NPI achieved:

- Consistent growth in newsletter subscribers and website engagement;
- Millions of social media impressions across platforms;
- Launch of “Full Disclosure with Danny Sheehan”, a weekly podcast produced in partnership with SpectreVision Radio, delivering timely analysis and updates on the disclosure process.

Advancing Equity, Jobs, and Access in California's Clean Energy Transition.

Mission

Let's Green CA! collaborates with underserved communities, working families, and climate and environmental justice organizations across California. Together, we build ground-up solutions to the climate crisis. We put jobs and workers first, cost and consumers first, equity and frontline communities first.

Completing a Chapter Expanding the Impact

From its inception, Let's Green CA! was built on a simple but urgent moral premise: we have a moral obligation to end the climate crisis and dramatically reduce carbon emissions — in a way that centers workers, frontline communities, and economic justice.

California, the world's fifth-largest economy, has the power to model climate solutions that can be replicated globally. Over nearly a decade under

the Romero Institute's leadership, Let's Green CA! showed that effective climate policy must center equity, labor protections, and community voice — offering approaches that can inform action far beyond the state. At the same time, the Romero Institute proved that nonprofit organizations can incubate bold climate initiatives that evolve into durable public infrastructure, community power, and statewide policy change.

Aligning Climate Action with Labor and Environmental Justice

Recognizing tensions between labor organizations, environmental justice advocates, and climate groups in California's energy transition, Let's Green CA! stepped in to facilitate dialogue and build shared solutions.

We built a coalition of 35+ labor, environmental justice, and climate organizations and helped advance workforce and environmental justice standards across

Community Choice Energy agencies.

Today, seven of the nine agencies within the California Community Power Joint Powers Authority have adopted these standards — helping ensure that renewable energy development creates family-supporting union jobs while respecting the needs of frontline communities.

Building a Community-Controlled Clean Energy System

Our climate work began in 2016, when our program—then called Greenpower—was selected by Santa Cruz County to lead outreach and education in Spanish-speaking and rural communities in support of a new public clean-energy initiative.

Our organizers knocked on 500 doors, made 3,000 phone calls, gathered 6,000 letters of support, and mobilized more than 700 residents to speak at city council and boards of supervisors meetings.

As a result, 17 cities and 3 counties joined what is now Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) — a locally

governed public agency created to give communities control over their electricity procurement.

When it launched in 2018, 3CE was the largest and most demographically diverse Community Choice Energy agency in California, shifting energy procurement across the Central Coast away from investor-owned utilities and toward publicly controlled clean energy.

To ensure that this new agency remained accountable to the communities it serves, Let's Green CA! later led a successful campaign to create a Community Advisory Council.

Let's Green CA! Impact 2017 to 2025

- **1000s of tons of annual carbon emissions do not enter the atmosphere** in our three counties as a result of 3CE, and San Luis Obispo, Half Moon Bay, and Santa Barbara County have also joined our community choice energy program
- **20,000 parishioners educated** on climate action and renewable energy
- **14 churches and schools** installed on-site solar power
- **Drafted and helped pass SB 1230 (2022)** expanding equitable access to clean vehicle incentives statewide in California
- Helped advance a **15,000-panel solar installation** at Graniterock's mining operations, reducing emissions associated with roughly 60% of the facility's production

Landmark Legislative Achievements

Let's Green CA! also advanced major policy reforms to ensure that clean energy transitions benefit working families.

In 2022, our team drafted and helped secure passage of SB 1230 (Limón), signed into law by Governor Gavin Newsom.

The legislation simplified access to California's clean vehicle incentive programs by allowing rebates to be applied directly at the point of sale, removing financial barriers that had prevented many low- and moderate-income households from

participating in the clean transportation transition.

At a time when transportation accounted for 40% of California's greenhouse gas emissions, SB 1230 marked a major step toward equitable electrification.

We also developed SB 823 (Smallwood-Cuevas), a proposal designed to address inequities in electric vehicle charging costs faced by renters and residents of multi-unit housing. Although the bill ultimately stalled due to statewide budget cuts in 2023, it advanced an important framework for equitable EV infrastructure.

Let's Green CA! Impact 2017 to 2025

- **Built a coalition of 35+ labor, environmental justice, and climate organizations** to advance workforce standards in renewable energy procurement.
- **Led outreach and education in underserved Central Coast communities to accelerate adoption of electric vehicles and home electrification technologies**, helping residents access state incentives to replace fossil-fuel appliances with healthier electric alternatives.
- **Created California's first solar-powered zero-carbon healthcare clinic** with a microgrid, serving farmworker communities in San Benito County

Turning Toward the Next Frontier

With the successful transition of Let's Green CA!, the Romero Institute has concentrated its climate focus on the New Paradigm Institute (NPI) initiative.

Our attention is now directed toward a largely hidden dimension of climate innovation: the existence of approximately 6,500 patent applications held under national security classification, including an estimated 1,600 classified energy-related innovations.

If even a fraction of these technologies involve advanced clean energy systems, their continued secrecy has profound implications for humanity's ability to address climate change.

Through NPI, we're developing a coordinated press, policy, and grassroots campaign to demand transparency and disclosure of these technologies.

As climate disruption accelerates, scientists, engineers, policymakers, environmental innovators, and the

public deserve access to every possible solution that could help humanity transition beyond fossil fuels.

Let's Green CA! helped lay the foundation for equitable climate action in California.

Now, that same commitment to justice drives us to ask a larger question:

What solutions may exist — and how might their release transform our collective future?

From launching public clean energy to advancing real-world solutions, **Let's Green CA!** created lasting climate infrastructure across California.

Transitioning the Work to Trusted Partners

In 2025, the Romero Institute transitioned the core components of Let's Green CA's work to trusted partner organizations so that the programs we incubated could continue expanding their impact.

Our workforce and procurement alignment efforts were transferred to The Climate Center, a statewide

climate policy organization positioned to scale these standards across California.

Meanwhile, our community electrification education programs were transferred to Environmental Innovations, which continues to provide hands-on electrification training and technical assistance in underserved communities.

These transitions reflect the success and maturation of the work. The alliances, policies, and infrastructure built by Let's Green CA! will continue shaping California's clean energy transition for years to come.

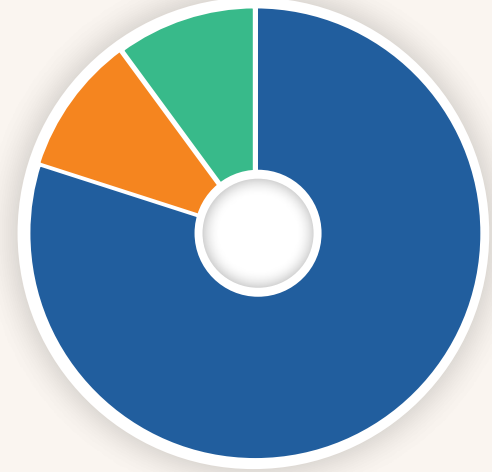

A Brief Word on the Year Ahead

The foundation we've built together over the past two years has been deliberate and disciplined. Across policy development, legal strategy, public education, and citizen organizing, Romero Institute has been laying the groundwork for a crucial moment.

The year ahead will focus on a unified UFO/UAP disclosure strategy — one that advances new federal legislation mandating full data turnover and congressional review, pursues accountability through criminal and, where necessary, civil litigation, and mobilizes a national pledge campaign concerning candidates seeking public office. These efforts are not siloed. They're designed to reinforce one another, applying pressure across diverse institutions while keeping the public informed and engaged.

Disclosure is not a single event or revelation. It's an unfolding process — one that requires persistence, ethical guardrails, and an activated citizenry committed to democratic oversight. At its core, disclosure is about responsible stewardship — of public trust, of democratic institutions, and of the shared planetary environment whose future depends on informed decision-making.

As the country enters another deeply polarized election cycle, the need for trustworthy institutions and informed participation has never been greater. Romero Institute exists for moments like this — to hold power to account, to defend constitutional principles, and to insist that the public has the right to know, particularly when secrecy carries consequences for the core health of life on Earth.

None of this work happens without sustained support. Your partnership makes it possible to plan rather than react, to pursue long-term outcomes rather than short-term wins, and to remain independent in both analysis and action.

As we look toward 2026, we invite you to continue standing with us — to help carry this work forward, deepen its impact, and ensure that truth, justice, and democratic accountability remain guiding principles in a time that urgently demands them.
