Fill in the base with a light blue shade.




Repeat step 2 using an even darker blue shade. Draw random small dots using a white gel pen.




Draw random dots to add shadow using a darker blue shade.



Add highlights with a white colored pencil or by smearing out a bit of acrylic paint.





Glowing snow



Start by adding a light yellow shade where you want the highlights to be.


Lightly add the Pink shade using the dotting technique.




Repeat step 2 using a blue shade.

Finish with some snow sparkles on top.

Beolistic snow




Fill the base with a light blue, then add random darker blue dots for shadow. Go in with another layer of random dots using an even darker blue shade.




Outline the snow using a white acrylic marker.

Add lots of random dots using a white gel pen to create snowflakes.
