1. Fill in the base and let everything dry completely




2. Add random patches with a dark brown shade for the cat and add shadow for the costume

2. Add shadows and blend with darker shades




3. Add random patches with a gray shade and random dots with a deep yellow shade, then add small pink details to the hat

1. Fill in the base, use yellow and dark gray to draw random patches and let everything dry completely




2. Add shadows and blend with a darker green shade and a lighter gray shade.
