


J-1 TEACHER PROGRAM

WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?

The J-1 Teacher Program is a cultural exchange program that allows accredited K-12 schools to host experienced, licensed international teachers for 3-5 years. International teachers bring strong professional backgrounds, cultural perspectives, and global awareness into U.S. classrooms. Participants are required to obtain a J-1 visa and apply through a designated sponsor.

All J-1 Teachers must have:

- A Bachelor's degree in Education (or in subject they intend to teach)
- A minimum of 2 years previous teaching experience
- English proficiency
- Certification to teach in their home country
