



2023-2024 Advanced Placement Courses

Accelerate Education participates in the AP Audit process by creating syllabi and submitting those syllabi for College Board approval. Any school partner that teaches using an Accelerate online Advanced Placement course will need to seek their own approvals through the college board through their own AP Course Audit account page, “claiming identical”. Schools should indicate the use of an AE course by selecting it from a dropdown menu during the submission process. The [AP Course Ledger](#) updates in November, where all courses listed for AE will be displayed. When searching for Accelerate, enter code #030682 in the High School Name or College Board School Code field on the ledger search page to see what courses we have approved (if you search by our name, you will see two different options, so using the code ensures accuracy); please remember this list will not be made public by the College Board until November.

Note: The ledger lists courses beginning with the 2007-08 academic year. AP courses offered prior to 2007-08 were not reviewed as part of the AP Course Audit; therefore, use of the "AP" designation is permitted for these courses.

Submit

You will need to set up your school at the College Board website with an administrator of your own. Your teachers will need to each create their own account at the College Board and associate that account with your school. The tech support number for assistance is 1-877-274-3570, option 5 (for course audit). Please note that we may have more than one instance listed for some of the courses because we have multiple teachers for AP courses. The CB requires that **each teacher** gets his or her own approval. For the purposes of demonstrating our approvals with school partners, we are listing only one syllabi and approval letter for each course.



All Accelerate Education’s approved Advanced Placement courses are listed below, along with the syllabi and approval numbers. When you submit these courses to “claim identical” (with the exception of AP Computer Science Principles, see directions below), you will need the approval # and the syllabus. Once approved, you will have your own authorization letter and approval #, with your teacher’s name. Accelerate’s official syllabi are linked below.

AP Courses offered by Accelerate Online Academy are available exclusively to students in grades 9-12, except for AP world language programs. [View the Appropriate Grade Level Policy.](#)

To be included on the AP Course Ledger, any AP courses offered through an Online Provider such as Accelerate Online Academy must be selected from the drop-down menu on my School Status page.

When using an approved AP course, teachers must verify that they have read the [AP Principles](#) and understand that the AP Program encourages educators to review these principles with parents and students, so they know what to expect in an AP course. Advanced Placement is always a choice, and it should be an informed one. AP teachers should be given the confidence and clarity that once parents have enrolled their child in an AP course, they have agreed to a classroom experience that embodies these principles.

Exam Administration

Each school partner will administer their own exams. Once the school is registered with the College Board as outlined above, they will have access to exam ordering.
