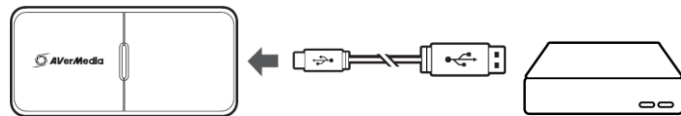


## Setting Up Live Streamer CAP 4K for Zoom Rooms

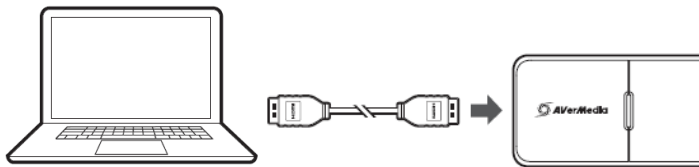
Follow the steps below to set up your Live Streamer CAP 4K (BU113) for the Zoom Rooms.

1. Connect the BU113's USB-C port to your video conferencing computer (i.e. a NUC or mini PC).



2. Once the BU113 is recognized by the system, it is ready to go—no driver is required.

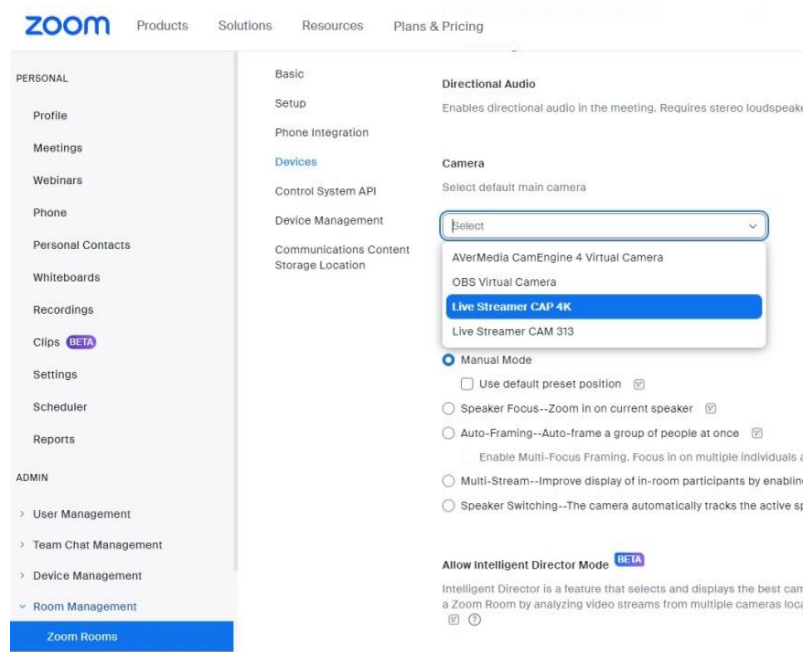
3. Connect the BU113's HDMI port to a laptop via an HDMI cable.



4. If you don't have a camera for the meeting room, you can set up BU113 as one in Zoom Rooms. Start Zoom Rooms > go to your Zoom account > ADMIN > Room Management > Zoom Rooms > Rooms > Edit (from the room where the meeting is held).
