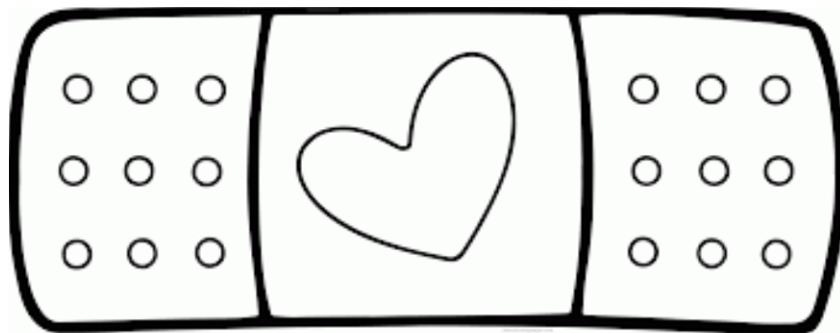
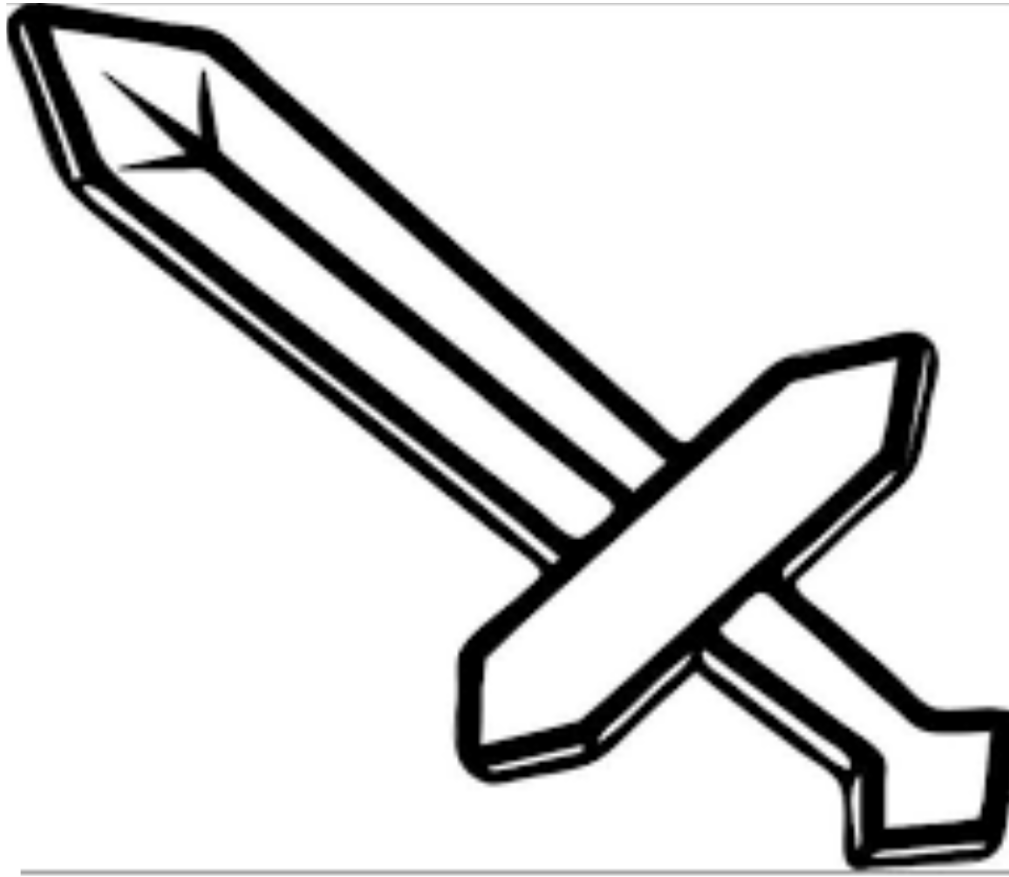

4. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS & BIBLE PRACTICE:

- Have your child use the table of contents to find the book of Proverbs. Is it in the New Testament or Old Testament? *Old*
- Find Proverbs chapter 15 (big number); verse 1 (little number).  
Have your child read Proverbs 15:1 out loud:

**"A gentle answer turns anger away. But mean words stir up anger."**

- According to this verse, what does a "gentle" answer do? *Turns anger away*
- What do "mean" words do? *Stir up anger*
- Ask your child to share an example of a time when he/she used gentle words to comfort or encourage someone. How did it make you and the other person feel?  
*Discuss*
- Ask your child to share an example of the opposite - a time when he/she used hurtful words towards someone. How did it make you and the other person feel?  
*Discuss*
