Served: Households that enrolled in a direct housing service including: Emergency Shelter (ES), Rapid Re-Housing (RRH), Homeless Prevention (HP), Services Only (SO), Transitional Housing (TH), Permanent Housing (PH), Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)

Enrollment: Every instance of entering a housing program. Enrollments for the same program have been de-duplicated for this summary report.

Household: A group of individuals that enroll together in a housing program, linked together in HMIS. A household can be a single individual or multiple individuals.

Coordinated Entry: A collaborative process that aims to connect homeless or imminent risk of homeless households to existing housing programs. A household can be enrolled in CE but not yet served in a direct housing service program.


