
#### **Ballot Instructions**

# Instructions



## **Marking Your Ballot**

Use a dark pen. Vote for one. If you vote for more than one, that race or measure will not count. To vote for a candidate not on the ballot, print the name on the blank line and fill in the oval to the left.



## **Making A Correction**

Draw a line through the entire candidate's name or response. To vote for another candidate or response, fill in the oval to the left of your new selection.

#### **Additional Information**

Sign and date the voter's declaration on the return envelope.

Return your ballot in a ballot drop box no later than 8:00 p.m. Election Day, or by mail (postmarked on or before Election Day).

#### City of Olympia & City of Tumwater Proposition No. 1 Formation of a Regional Fire Authority

The City of Olympia and City of Tumwater adopted a Joint Resolution concerning formation of a regional fire authority and its Plan.

If approved, this proposition would form the Olympia Tumwater Fire Authority and adopt the Plan to provide fire protection and emergency medical services. The Authority will be funded by property tax (not to exceed \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value) and a six-year benefit charge (not to exceed 60% of the Authority's operating budget). This funding would reduce Olympia's and Tumwater's property tax capacity by the tax rate collected by the Authority.
