## What do you need and why? Include any unexpected and external requirements.

Statement of Need

The PAO requests the addition of a Community Program Manager position for the Target Zero Program which is funded by the Washington Traffic Safety Commission. This position would manage grant funding for the purpose of conducting high visibility, data driven emphasis patrols throughout Thurston County.

#### How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

The Community Program Manager position will be managing grant monies from the Washington Traffic Safety Commission for the purpose of conducting high visibility, data-driven emphasis patrols throughout Thurston County. The use of data driven approaches to identify the appropriate dates and locations of emphasis patrols have proven an effective strategy in reducing traffic fatalities and serious injuries. This work has been performed by the Resource Development Specialist on a part-time basis, but the program and WTSC prefer a full-time position to manage the work. In addition, WTSC will contract with the PAO to fund the position 100%.

#### Expenditure, FTE and revenue assumptions plus current budget level

#### Assumptions

The current three-year contract for services between the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC) and the Thurston County Prosecutor's Office in the amount of \$67,500 per year is set to expire on 9/30/2023. WTSC does not want the Prosecutor's Office to have any financial loss with the arrangement and is willing to cover the salary, benefits, and any necessary indirect costs for a dedicated full-time Community Program Manager position to handle the Target Zero Manager duties.

The base budget for PAO includes \$67,500 in revenue in both 2024 and 2025. The revenue of \$49,889 in both years of this request is the net difference that we will receive.

Impacts and Alternatives

With the recent uptick in traffic fatalities across the state and region, there is a clear need for a dedicated position to address traffic safety issues to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries. In the last five years alone, we have seen annual traffic fatalities increase 33% in Washington. Without a dedicated full-time position, it's possible the traffic fatality and serious injuries rates would continue to rise. If the position is not approved, WTSC would need to find another partner agency to host the Target Zero Manager.

#### How does this request affect other offices and departments?

Impact to Other Departments

Which Other Departments are Affected? Thurston County Sheriff's Office is one of the partner agencies in the Thurston County Target Zero Task Force, and the program provides overtime funding for high-visibility emphasis (HVE) patrols. With traffic fatalities and serious injuries on the rise, there is a heightened need for HVE patrols. If the Target Zero Manager position is not funded or filled, TCSO would either not participate in HVE patrols or the expense for HVE overtime funding would fall to the County. There is no clear impact on any other offices or departments within the County.
