What do you need and why? Include any unexpected and external requirements.

Statement of Need

The Prosecuting Attorney's office would like to create three Paralegal II positions for assignment to the Criminal Division. The Criminal Division needs Paralegal IIs to provide higher level assistance to the deputy prosecutors and provide management of the caseloads and support staff in the areas of Domestic Violence and Special Victims, Misdemeanors and Juvenile, and General Felony. The cases have become more complex with a signifcant amount of digital discovery. Navigating through the criminal justice system has become increasingly challenging with the volume of cases referred and filed in Thurston County. There are six Paralegal I positions currently assigned to the Criminal Division. Creation of three Paralegal II positions would provide critical support to the Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys giving the attorneys more capacity to review referrals and prepare for hearings and trials.

How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys will have more time to review referrals and evidence and prepare cases for hearings and trials. Caseload management and support staff oversight will give Team Leaders more capacity to provide training and mentoring to the Deputy Prosecutors.

Expenditure, FTE and revenue assumptions plus current budget level

Assumptions

The difference between a Paralegal I and Paralegal II position is one step. The PAO proposes internal promotions and elimination of the position held by the employee selected for the Paralegal II position. The cost for 2024 for three positions is \$9,705 and \$10,884 for 2025.

Current Budget Level

Paralegal I salary: Range 10 - \$4,421 - \$5,880 Paralegal II salary: Range 11 - \$4,642 - \$6,174 The difference is 5%. 2024 cost: \$3,235 for each position 2025 cost: \$3,628 for each position

What happens if this isn't funded? Are there other options?

Impacts and Alternatives

The alternative is going through a reclassification process. The cost difference would be the same. The PAO is giving up three positions in exchange for three Paralegal II positions.
