Statement of Need

Funding is requested for food services for an additional 152 inmates. In 2022, the Sheriff's Office put out to bid food services for a new contract that began January 1, 2023. The chosen vendor's rate for inmate meals is \$2.17 per meal and \$4.20 per meal for staff meals. The previous vendor's rate was \$1.45 per meal (both inmate and staff meals).

The current level of funding covers the cost of staff meals (\$105,488/year = \$4.20/meal X 483 meals per week X 52 weeks. Staff meals are required by their labor contract.) and meals for 248 inmates (\$590,027 (remainder of current allotment for food services) divided by \$2.17 = 271,902 meals divided by 1,095 meals (3 meals per day X 365 days) = 248 inmates. With the jail reopening August 1, 2023, we anticipate the jail population will increase to 400 inmates. Therefore, funding is requested to cover the cost of meals for 152 inmates (400 inmates less the funded level for 248 inmates).
