Statement of Need

The Coroner's Office is requesting a Chief Deputy Coroner. A Chief Deputy Coroner will assist the Coroner in the administration and management of the Office with an emphasis on the immediate and crucial responsibility of attaining Coroner's Office accreditation. HB1326 requires accreditation January 1st, 2025 to continue receiving reimbursements, of which the County received \$235,103 last year.

How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

Chief Deputy Coroner assists the Coroner in the day-to-day administration and management of the Office while directly supervising the operations of Investigations and Pathology. There are currently 16 staff members and volunteers supervised by the Coroner. The span of control is too great for the Coroner alone and a second-in-command is needed. In addition, a Chief Deputy Coroner will be responsible for implementing policies and procedures under the direction of the Coroner. As you know, HB 1326 requires Office accreditation beginning January 1st, 2025. A Chief Deputy Coroner will immediately be tasked with preparing the Office to become accredited. Office accreditation directly effects the percentage at which reimbursements are made and additionally, most grant funding organizations are now requiring recipients to be accredited. Furthermore, in the absence of the Coroner, a Chief Deputy will continue the services provided by the Coroner's Office without interruption or delay, including arranging for autopsies and media interactions. Of the 39 counties in WA state, we are the largest Coroner's Office and the only Coroner's Office without a Chief Deputy Coroner.
