Statement of Need

This request is to reimburse members for commuting costs when attending meetings.

Thurston County is committed to equity and believes that county residents who contribute their expertise and life experience while participating on a County advisory board or commission should be compensated for their time and expertise. Stipends are also intended to compensate for transportation, childcare, parking and other costs associated with a member participating in the work of the advisory board or commission. This came from the brainstorming session.

How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

a. Encourages economic diversity, granting individuals an opportunity to serve who may not otherwise have been able to do so.

b. Promotes dignity and equitable access to participate if stipends are offered for all county community advisory boards and commissions rather than based on disclosure of one's personal finances.

c. Reduces the burden of rising inflation and the cost of travel to and from in person meetings.

d. Promotes racial equity and health equity by broadening participation in committees.

e. Reduces barriers to participation for individuals who may be low income, have childcare costs, be unemployed, or work in jobs that do not allow them paid time for committee participation.

f. Promotes inclusion of individuals with personal and/or lived experience in areas relevant to committee efforts, such as Thurston County residents who have faced homelessness or behavioral health challenges.

Expenditure, FTE and revenue assumptions plus current budget level

Assumptions

1) Advisory Board or Commission members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners (BoCC) are eligible to receive a stipend if the following conditions are met:

a. The individual is serving an active term on a BoCC board or commission.

b. The individual is not receiving compensation by another party, organization, or individual for attending the board or commission meetings, unless payment of stipend is required by RCW.

c. Annually, the individual completes a conflict-of-interest disclosure form.

d. The individual must complete and submit an IRS W-9 form and any other document required by the County to process payment.

2) Receipt of a stipend is optional. All eligible members will be given an option to request the stipend. Those that request a stipend must demonstrate that they meet the eligibility requirements listed under item 2. Eligible members may change their selection at any time, but retro-active stipend payments are not permitted.

3) Stipends may be for up to \$50 for per meeting. Proof of attendance must be provided. Timesheets will not be required.

Estimated cost = 12 Meetings per year X 29 Boards X 4 Members who will ask for stipend X \$50 = \$69,600
