Statement of Need

This request is expanding upon the approved Mitigation plan to continue the plan further.

This will enable tangible progress in implementing two high-impact greenhouse gas reduction strategies in the Plan: Strategy T3 "Increase adoption of electric vehicles," and Strategy B1 "Reduce energy use in existing residential buildings." First, completing an Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Assessment is a necessary first step to enable the County to achieve its green fleet goals and compete for grant funding to install EV chargers. Second, the request will help scale a regional Home Energy Efficiency & Electrification Campaign that will leverage a federal formula grant and be implemented in collaboration with the three cities. In addition to these priority initiatives, this request covers administrative and technical support for TCMP implementation. This funding request is strategically developed to maximize its impact by leveraging other sources of grant funding and the regional partnership of the Thurston Climate Mitigation Collaborative.

Impacts and Alternatives

Without funding, the County will not be able to implement TCMP strategies and will not meet its target of reducing greenhouse gas emissions 45% by 2030 and 85% by 2050. Without local government action to reduce emissions, the international community will fail to limit global warming to the threshold necessary to avoid the most catastrophic effects of climate change. Specifically, not completing the EV infrastructure assessment will make the County less competitive for grants and will slow progress on fleet electrification. Not funding the Home Energy Efficiency & Electrification Campaign will limit the reach of this campaign to only what is covered by the limited grant dollars, in which case very few County residents would be able to participate in the home energy and electrification program.
