Statement of Need

Thurston County Central Services would like to request adding a new classification and an additional FTE to our Facilities Division. This new position would be a Facilities Control Specialist. Based upon the square footage of the county buildings, Facilities should have a staff of 34 employees per the standard of the International Facility Management Association (FSA). This position is needed to reduce the wait times for troubleshooting errors in the system and to maintain the HVAC systems to run efficiently.

How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

Having a Control Specialist on staff would result in quicker response times for HVAC related control issues as we currently use vendors and have to wait to get on their work schedule. It would greatly reduce the amount of outsourcing that is currently done with outside vendors. Currently, \$30,000 to \$55,000 annually is spent on these services. This position would also have general knowledge in other systems that the county currently uses vendors for, such as card access systems and fire alarm systems.
