Statement of Need

The Roads and Transportation division is requesting a project increase of \$2,146,310 for the Thompson Creek Rd at Thompson Creek Fish Passage project (CP #63025), for a total project budget of \$2.24M. This request includes \$1,646,310 in Real Estate Excise Tax 2 (REET2) funding designated as a part of the Fish Passage Program. This project recently received a \$500K grant from the Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) which is included in this request and was previously awarded a \$80K grant (also through RCO) which has already been recognized in the budget.

This project will remove a fish passage barrier along Thompson Creek at the crossing of Thompson Creek Road SW. The existing 11-foot culvert is considered a barrier to fish and will need to be replaced to enhance fish passage. The existing 8-ft wide squashed pipe is considered by WA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife a partial barrier to fish due to lack of streambed depth and velocity. An alternative analysis recommended the replacement structure be a 70-ft bridge to provide enhanced fish passage. The new bridge will open access to more than 10 miles of habitat. This project is ranked as a high-priority site according to the Chehalis Basin Prioritization regional map.
