Statement of Need

The Roads & Transporation division is requesting 2 Road Operations Supervisor FTEs and vehicles. These positions will track road maintenance, construction, emergency response (24-hour emergency call out) and other related road operation activities for the Road Operations division. Road Operations Supervisors direct, plan, and oversee work assignments and set priorities for the division's crews, including vegetation, surfacing, drainage, and NPDES, coordinate activities with other departments/offices and agencies, and assist in the preparation and administration of the Division's budget. This request is based on a recently completed consultant report assessing Road Operations staffing, structure and operations, which identified deficiencies in the current Road Operations organizational structure. Specifically, these two positions will expand the Road Operations supervisory structure to four, reducing the span of control (or crew size) to more manageable levels in alignment with best industry practices, and enabling the division to rebalance the workload between supervisors and crew chiefs. Currently the supervisors have a span of control of 25-30 staff each; a recommended span of control is generally 10:1. This shift in responsibilities will be to enable crew chiefs to focus on core responsibilities, including increased time in the field overseeing the work of the crews leading to improved operational productivity, level of service, and more efficient operations meeting the needs of the county.

Costs associated with these positions are \$267K and \$276K for 2024 and 2025 respectively, with a one-time purchase of 2 vehicles in 2024 at an estimated cost of \$120K.

### How will this change the performance of your office or department?

#### Statement of Need

The 2 additional Road Operations Supervisors will lead to improved prioritization of resources, planning of work, scheduling and documentation of work activities and results. These two positions will improve our asset management practices and information which will result in better data for planning, decision-making, and financial investment in our infrastructure assets. In addition, they will free up time for the crew chiefs to focus on their core responsibilities which will directly improve outcomes in the field.
