Statement of Need

Community Planning and Economic Development requests \$150,000 over the biennial budget to update Thurston County's current Flood Hazard Mitigation Plan which expired at the end of 2022. The plan is required as part of the county's participation in the National Flood Insurance Program Community Ratings System program. The plan needs to be updated by the next CRS verification visit in 2025. The funding would be used for professional services to update the plan. The County is joining Pierce and King Counties as one of eight Class 2 communities in the country.

How will this change the performance of your office or department?

Statement of Need

This funding from the Surface and Stormwater fund will ensure the county remains a Class 2 CRS community under the National Flood Insurance Program. With this rating, property owners with flood insurance receive a 40 percent discount on their insurance.
